You can learn a lot about Virginia wine just by looking at a map. Situated between the traditions of Europe and the innovation of California, Virginia sits at a true crossroads of winemaking.

While viticulture here dates back centuries—most famously with Thomas Jefferson's Monticello estate—the modern revival began in the 1970s. Italian winemaker Gianni Zonin of Barboursville Vineyards and viticulturist Gabriele Rausse began successfully grafting European varietals onto American rootstocks, paving the way for a new generation of winemakers like Luca Paschina, Michael Shaps, and Jim Law.
