# VIRGINIA GEMS

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*You can learn a lot about Virginia wine just by looking at a map. Situated between the traditions of Europe and the innovation of California, Virginia sits at a true crossroads of winemaking.*

*While viticulture here dates back centuries—most famously with Thomas Jefferson’s Monticello estate—the modern revival began in the 1970s. Italian winemaker Gianni Zonin of Barbourville Vineyards and viticulturist Gabriele Rausse began successfully grafting European varietals onto American rootstocks, paving the way for a new generation of winemakers like Luca Paschina, Michael Shaps, and Jim Law.*

*Today, Virginia is known for distinctive expressions of Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Viognier, and the native Norton grape. At the center is the Monticello AVA—named Wine Enthusiast’s 2023 Wine Region of the Year—where a community of growers crafts wines that embody both Old World finesse and New World spirit.*

  - **Biodynamic:** A step beyond organic, this holistic approach treats the vineyard as a living system—often guided by lunar cycles and incorporating animals, plants, and compost to create a balanced ecosystem.
  - **Sustainable:** Looks at the bigger picture, balancing environmental care with economic and social responsibility to ensure vineyards thrive for generations to come.
