# Stay and Sip

The Four Seasons Resort and Residences Napa Valley is the brand's first property to be set within a working winery. —MM

The much-anticipated Four Seasons Resort and Residences Napa Valley opened last November to high acclaim. Led by General Manager Mehdi Eftekari, the property sets a new standard for modern luxury in the region. Nestled within Calistoga, the resort features only 85 rooms and suites for an intimate experience. The largest accommodation at the resort is the 3,395-square-foot stand-alone Estate Villa, which boasts an expansive living area that opens to a broad terrace overlooking a private pool and garden, a separate media room, indoor and outdoor dining areas, and three en suite bedrooms.

The resort also boasts a bevy of open-air spaces surrounded by panoramic views of the mountains and vineyards. Highlighted by the Elusa Winery at its heart, the property is home to the signature Truss Restaurant + Bar situated in a lush vineyard setting. Try the signature pressed chicken, served with seasonal butternut squash, Fresno peppers, popped black rice and herbs. In addition, the restaurant features private dining in the

Cork Room and a demonstration kitchen for private and group classes in mixology, wine pairings or gaucho-style cooking on an Argentinian wood-burning grill.

The Four Seasons partnered with Thomas Rivers Brown, a Calistoga resident who has received national acclaim during his 25-year winemaking career, in the Elusa Winery and its 4.7-acre organic vineyard. Guests of the resort can enjoy the signature Elusa wines in the Tasting Room, at Truss or in the privacy of their guest room, suite or Private Retreat (farmhouse-style villas that include open-concept kitchens, a resident chef if desired and a dedicated Four Seasons host). There are hands-on demonstrations, opportunities to meet the winemakers and, of course, plenty of wine tastings that include a variety of wines from the Napa region.

The Four Seasons Resort and Residences Napa Valley also features locally inspired indoor-outdoor spa experiences through its Spa Talisa. In an area known for its hot springs, a mud treatment at the

spa is a must-try. Several outdoor decks offer locally inspired misting experiences, while the spa treatment menu designed by Spa Director Natalie Posner offers a series of bespoke massages. Try the Brave Spirit Body Ritual for an invigorating and restorative experience. There's also a fully equipped fitness center, including an outdoor deck for spin classes.
