All the Reasons to Hit Napa and Sonoma Right Now

California's beloved wine destinations have plenty of fresh offerings when it comes to world-class hotels, dynamic food and more (mud baths with the works!) By Kathryn Romeyn

D uring the COVID pandemic, California's wine mecca counties seem to have taken a cue from the grapes they grow so beautifully: strain and adversity have produced a bold bounty of new ventures.

WHERE TO STAY Healdsburg will soon welcome The Madrona (from \$650 per night), a sprawling 1881 residence reimagined by interior designer Jay Jeffers into a 24-room hotel. Says Jeffers, a coowner, of choosing to open in the Sonoma town, "It truly has the best of both worlds with its lively culinary scene, luxury spas and world-class wineries. all while



maintaining a small-town-charm feel." ... In Napa, the new Stanly Ranch (from \$1,259 a night) is an Auberge Resorts Collection property on a historic 712-acre working ranch that combines a sustainable culinary program with opportunities to pick ingredients for one's own dinner. . Sonoma's Stavrand Russian River Valley (from \$249) in Guerneville offers 21 plush rooms on six acres of redwood groves and orchards. .. Celebrating its 50th anniversary, Sonoma's Jordan Vineyard & Winery, also in Sonoma, has debuted gorgeous redos of its four chateau suites, available to Gold and Platinum members of its rewards program (from \$150 to \$250, plus 5,000 points a person).

WHERE TO EAT Downtown Healdsburg is abuzz with fresh restaurant concepts, including comfort food-focused Lo & Behold; soon-to-open Little Saint, a collaboration that includes celebrity designer Ken Fulk and the owners of SingleThread Farms; and chef Dustin Valette's The Matheson, where Kate Hudsor recently dined. Valette says the intention was to create "an unpretentious, warm and inviting community" and recommends "a cocktail on our rooftop." Eightyeight vintages are available by the glass at the wine wall. ... The deluxe new 85-key Four Seasons Resort and Residences Napa Valley features the rustic Calistoga's Living Room, where plates include duck ham with Espelette pepper.

WHAT TO DO One of Sonoma's most award-winning labels, Vérité, opened a tasting salon outside Healdsburg, where a library comparison tasting 1 A guest at Dr. Wilkinson's Backyard Resort 6 Mineral Springs. 2 A bathroom at Stahy Ranch. 3 Vhyard Views from The Madrona. 4 An al freaco table set for guests at Stavrand Russian River Valley. 5 Steehead torout with sunchokes and mussels at The Matheson. 6 A badroom inside one of Jordan Vineyard & Winery's renovated chateau suites.

(\$350) allows aficionados to explore how three vintages match up with current pours. ... A handful of SingleThread alum have joined forces for an openuntil-2 a.m. wine bar dubbed Maison Healdsburg, due soon. ... Calistoga's toxin-eliminating mud baths are famous, including the ones at Dr. Wilkinson's Backyard Resort & Mineral Springs, which has reopened after a total reimagining. Go for The Works (\$329), a mud bath with facial mask, mineral whirlpool bath, geo-steam room, blanket wrap and massage.

On the Market in Napa

Located in Napa County's St. Helena (where **Robert Redford** sold an estate in 2019 for 57 million), this seven-bedroom, lake-view home on 41 acres is inspired by renovated Meiji-era homes in Japan. In addition to the main house (built of cedar, steel and glass), here's a studio, guest house, gym, home theater, tennis court and pool. It's listed with **Hillary Ryan** of Sotheby's International Realty for \$26 million. – DEGEN PENER



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
