Jeio NV/ Valdobbiadene, Italy

Bright Aromas of fresh green apple, with notes of citrus fruit, peach, apricot, and banana. White flowers and vegetal notes of freshly cut grass complement the spicy finish. Dry with consistent body, this wine is elegant, fresh, and crispy.

## VEUVE CLICQOUT

Yellow Label, Brut NV/ Champagne, France

Dry, balanced, and full flavored with elegance, crispness, and a lingering Pinot Noir finish. Yellow straw color with white fruits and vanilla and toasty notes.

Champagne, France

Soft and mature aromas of white fruits such as peaches and pears with hints of hazelnuts. This wine exhibits flavors of pear, peach, apple, and gooseberry with brioche and cereal notes

## CAVA BRUT RESERVA CORPINNAT

these vineyards are farmed organically and without irrigation. An elegant Cava, a very bright pale straw- yellow color. it displays a fine, constant mousse and a very clean aroma which balances to perfection the subtle fruit notes with nutty aromas acquired from aging. On the palate it is light and fine, fresh and unctuous, completely dry, smooth and with pleasant nuances from aging.

## DOM PERIGNON VINTAGE 2012

Champagne, France

A year full of paradoxes for winemaking, 2012 gave birth to a great vintage, surmounting multiple challenges. A series of climate events descended upon the vineyards: frost in the winter and spring, torrential rains, hailstorms and cold spells while the vines were flowering, plus intense heat waves over the summer. A warm and dry climate alleviated any concerns as to the health of grapes, favoring the maturation of the fruit. The harvest begins on September 10. Tasting the grapes revealed tremendous promise, with a balance between freshness and generosity.

A note of almond gives this wine a characteristic finish

**VERMENTINO / SUPERIOIRE DOCG #110  
Sella & Mosca 2021/ Gallura, Sardinia, Italy**

The bright straw yellow color announces captivating aromas, as refined as they are pronounced. Rich in fruited notes, it smoothly progresses to hints of herbs, berries, flowers, and shrubs. On the palate it begins smoothly but with considerable complexity, enlivened by a brilliant acidity that gives it depth and extension. The Mediterranean character is always present with marine notes underlying the flavor

**CHENIN BLANC #115  
Sauvignon 2020/ Vouvray, Loire Valley, France**

The nose features notes of honeysuckle and ripe citrus fruit. On the palate, the wine is off-dry and medium bodied with food-friendly acidity. Flavors of honeycomb, ripe pear, golden apples, and quince lead to a long finish. Pair this medium bodied wine with medium bodied or spiced dishes.

Sonoma, CA #140

On the palate there's lots of ripple apple, lemon zest, melon, vanilla, brioche, and stone fruits. Full bodied with ripe and creamy palate balanced with fresh acidity.

CAKEBREAD #145

Cellars Reserve 2020 Carneros, Napa, CA

\$150

This wine opens up with aromas of ripe golden apple, white peach, and notes of oak. On the palate, apple and pear characters are balanced by fresh acidity, and the finish is clean, with appealing mineral notes.

El Molino 2019 #150

Rutherford, Napa, CA

\$125

Displays a luminous pale gold, with green rim in the glass. A nose of Meyer lemon, grapefruit zest, ginger and fresh pineapple. On the palate a delightfully broad entry leads to a viscous and rich midpalate with lovely weight.

Petite Chablis, France

A pale yellow wine with notes of white fruits, lemon, and grapefruit. On the palate, this is a pure and lively wine which has good acidity and notes of ripe apple.

Very expressive nose with lemon curd and white flowers that offer a true expression of the Chassagne terroir. Vibrant Minerality and acidity without being aggressive. Lush mouthfeel and lingering finish.

**PINOT NOIR #201**

**Southern Lines 2020 Central Otago, NZ**

Lifted aromas of wild cherry opening to savory and elegant floral notes. Powerful yet elegant Pinot Noir displaying bright cherry fruits underlined by ripe and silky tannins. The palate combines acidity and roundness giving texture and exceptionally good length.

**PINOT NOIR #205**

**Pinot Noir / Charlotte Louis 2021 / Oregon**

**\$65**

Lively acidity is well balanced with spice, black cherry, plums and floral notes. On the palate it is smooth, round, and medium-bodied with flavors of tart cherry, orange zest, rhubarb and clove. Its lively acidity carries through the palate, followed by a flavorful elegant finish

**PINOT NOIR # 210 DUMOL 2021**

**"Wester Reach Vineyard" / Russian Rive Valley, CA**

The wine's aromas and flavors encompass the entire spectrum of red and black fruits. There are savory spices and an earthy undertone of black cherry, wild berries, dried thyme, orange zest, sandalwood, and black tea. The palate is supple, broad, and lively. The silky structure flows seamlessly to a crunchy vibrant finish with a rising red-mineral lift.

**Bertani 2021 / Veneto, Italy**

Bright hints of red currants, plums, raspberries, and sour cherries balanced by spicy notes reminiscent of pepper and cinnamon. On the palate it is approachable, fresh, and pleasant, thanks to good balance between acidity, savory notes, and richness of flavor. A blend of Corvina and Rondinella.

**TEMPRANILLO #220**

**Sierra Cantabra Crianza 2018 / D.O.C.A. Roja, Spain**

Shiny ruby red color with good layers. Intense, complex, and warm on the nose with an aging bouquet of fresh and ripe fruits combined with touches of spices, vanilla, and toast. On the palate it is velvety, complex, and full. The developing red fruits stand out. Powerful and elegant at the same time. Lingering finish of vanilla, light balsamic, and red fruits.

ROUND & JUICY

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**THE PESSIMIST # 230**

**2022 PASO ROBLES, CA**

**\$75**

Intensely aromatic nose that ascends to greet you with blueberry, boysenberry, and black plum, and the palate expresses the essence of pure dark berry fruit. The layers of elderberry and truffle, with cocoa and cardamom spice accents, are further augmented by hints of eucalyptus, leather, cherry pipe tobacco, and grilled meats. The finish is smooth and leisurely.

**OPUS ONE 2017**

**Oakville, CA # 235**

This delicious wine starts with initial notes of dark fruit, exotic spice, violet, black tea, and sage, followed by hints of vanilla, cocoa, and baking spices. Silky, fine-grained tannins provide structure and an enticing creamy texture.

**CANNANOU RISERVA # 240**

**Sella & Mosca 2020/ Sardegna, Italy**

**\$60**

100% Grenache, the wine has an intense bouquet of violets, kirsch, and red jammy fruit, accented by balsamic notes and wild herbs.

**GARNACHA # 245**

**Bodegas Brecca 2021**

**\$60**

**D.O. Calatayud, Aragon, Spain**

This plump red offers juicy flavors of dark cherry and crushed red plum that are infused with anise, mocha, and wild herb elements, framed by thick tannins. 100% Garnacha de Aragón, the oldest clone of Garnacha (Grenache) in the world. Garnacha (Grenache) was first cultivated in this northeastern corner of Spain and transferred across the Mediterranean by the Kingdom of Aragón.

**CHATEAUNEUF - DU - PAPE # 250**

**Domaine de Beaugard 2020/ France**

This medium to full-bodied, concentrated classic cuvée has plenty of ripe tannins, and a freshness and acidity typical of the vintage. Aromas of dark cherry and currant fruits abound, as well as an ample minerality on the nose. There are additional notes of new leather and scorched earth, which all result in a wine of terrific balance. **Made with Organic Grapes.**

**CILIEGIOLO # 255**

**Piancornello "per emma" 2019/ Tuscany, Italy**

Intense, ruby red with a scent of black and red cherries, balanced with spice and herbal notes. The palate is rich, with perceptible and well-structured tannins, a full body and a tasty, long finish. **Made with Organic Grapes and a House Favorite.**

## **SUPER TUSCAN #260**

**Col D'Orcia 2020 / Tuscany, Italy** **\$60**

On the nose, fruity and vinous with intense aromas of ripe wild berries. On the palate, full, soft and persistent with pleasant ripe tannins and a long and fruit-forward finish. A blend of Sangiovese and Ciliegiolo.

## **CHIANTI CLASSICO, DOCG #265**

**Costello Di Verrazano 2019 / Tuscany, Italy**

Ruby red color with purplish reflexes, intense scent, rich in flavors of red mature fruits such as cherry and blackberry blended with floral notes. The taste is harmonic with oak striations, a fine and sweet tannic component and pleasant hints of red fruits. Made with Organic Grapes and Unfiltered. **\$70**

## **POGGIOTONDO #270**

**Brunello di Montalcino Tuscany Italy 2019** **\$90**

Aromas of strawberry, black cherry, violet, and aged leather. The palate is giving and complex with flavors of crushed red fruit, tomato leaf, and a hint of cocoa. Firm tannins and bright acidity keep this wine fresh and lively. A really focused and rounded Brunello with lovely velvety tannins that give this length and grandeur. It's medium- to full-bodied with a lovely intensity and texture. A beautiful young Brunello. **96 points James Suckling**

## **BARBARESCO DOCG / #275**

**Fontanafredda 2019 / Piemonte, Italy** **\$90**

On the nose, light vanilla, intense underbrush and violets. A robust, well bodied wine packed with structure and capable of withstanding the test of time. This wine has soft and lingering tastes which is full and velvety.

## **BOLGHERI SASSICAIA, DOC #280**

**Tenuta San Guido 2019 / Bolgheri, Tuscany, Italy** **\$540**

Comprised of 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Cabernet Franc; Aromas of rich, black cherry and black currant flavored red, accented by cedar, wild herb, and spice notes. This wine is supple and vibrant, with a lingering aftertaste of fruit and an emerging mineral element. Firms up nicely on the finish.

**Reserve de L'Abbe 2020/**

**Southern Rhone Valley, France**

Bramble black fruits and red berry fruits of cherries and raspberries. Provençal herbs and brown backing spices with gentle tannins. The wine is direct with a lovely soft finish.

**BORDEAUX 2019 #300**

**\$90**

**Chateau Les Petits Arnauds Blaye Cotes de**

Deep red in color with spices and cherries on the nose. The wine is flesh, fruit-driven with flavors of black pepper, sultanas and dried cherries. Finish is elegant, slightly tannic and long-lasting. Pair very well with stews, grilled meats and lamb or just by itself.

**BORDEAUX #295**

**Les Legendes by Barons Rothschild Lafite 2018**

**Saint-Emillion, France**

Dark red in color. Expressive cherries and blueberries and vanilla notes from the oak. Soft, round tannins and a freshness on the palate.

**Defaix Freres 2020/ Rully, France**

All freshness and fruit, this Rully is very representative of the Burgundian style of Pinot Noir.

**BURGUNDY PREMIER CRU #305**

**Antoine Oliver "Beaurepaire" 2019**

**Santenay, France**

Classic red Burgundy with fine red fruit tones and a silky texture. Long and elegant on the finish with 12 months of barrel aging.

**MALBEC 2022 #315**

**Cepas De Familia / Mendoza, Argentina**

strong fruity aromas highlighting notes of plum and spice. Medium bodied with round, so tannins and a long, velvety finish. It pairs well with grilled red meat, stews and pastas.

**BIG & ADVENTUROUS**

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**OLD VINE RED ZINFANDEL #320**

**Girard 2019 Napa, CA**

**\$75**

The nose reveals racy aromas of blackberry jam, cherry cobbler and spicy white pepper. Plum, cherry, and dried herb flavors flood the palate, framed by a careful selection of Fusion barrel oak; savory notes imparted by the American oak, Hungarian oak elevates Zinfandels' characteristic sweet spice, and the French oak affords the wine a smooth and luxurious finish.

**BORDEAUX BLEND #325**

**\$90**

**Hedges Family Estate 2019/ Red Mountain, WA**

Cassis, blackberry, dark chocolate, leather, coffee, with a hint of cloves and toasted hazelnuts. Full and rounded palate with bright, intense fruit and a lush cocoa, spicy finish. This wine has a classic Hedges style with a modern touch, very enjoyable now and will age for years to come. Aged 21 months in barrel. Organic and Salmon safe.

**SPANISH RED BLEND #330**

**Gran Clos "Finca el Puig" 2019**

**\$90**

**D.O.Ca. Priorat, Spain**

A blend of Garnatxa Negra, Carinyena & Syrah. Fresh and ripe with notes of red and black fruits (raspberry, blackberry) plus floral, forest herb and balsamic aromas. It stands out for its minerality. On the palate it is well balanced, with volume, expression, and good acidity. Fruity texture and fine structure. Ripe fruit, floral and forest herbs aftertaste.

**CABERNET SAUVIGNON PAYS D'OC #335**

**\$60**

**"La Forge Estates" 2021 Languedoc, France**

This wine has intense scents of red berries, red pepper, and tobacco notes underlined with cocoa and spicy vanilla aromas. A full bodied wine with smooth tannins, ripe cherries, vanilla and spice, which linger on the long finish.

**CABERNET SAUVIGNON #340**

**\$68**

**BonAnno 2021/ Napa, CA**

Deep ruby in color with fresh black cherry, plum, blackberry, cedar, and hints of vanilla. The texture is smooth and sleek in the mouth with firm tannins and fresh acidity. The palate is loaded with fresh blackberry, plum, currants, and hints of cinnamon and vanilla. 26 months in French Oak.

**CABERNET SAUVIGNON #345**

**Force & Grace /Napa, CA**

**\$95**

This wine is bright, silky, and evolves as it lingers on the palate. Concentrated flavors of plum, dried cherry, blackberry fruit leather, and black tea are complemented by rich, silky tannins and integrated acidity. On the finish, notes of cedar, cacao, nutmeg, and licorice add subtle layers of complexity that lift and provide an elegant structure to the blend while offering a distinctly intense aroma to the nose.

BIG & ADVENTUROUS

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CABERNET SAUVIGNON #350

\$120

Mount Veeder Winery 2019/ Mt Veeder, Napa, CA

Aromas of wonderfully rich, ripe berries and summer cherry pie on the nose are complemented by hints of earth, cedar, rosemary, and dried sage. Dark cassis fruit layers with bright blackberry build complexity with additional layers of mocha and peppercorn.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON #355

\$150

Davies Vineyard 2018/ St. Helena, Napa, CA

Opens with rich aromas of blackberry, plum, and black cherry, and is accentuated with notes of chai spice, cinnamon, and dark chocolate. Present tannins and a vibrant acidity anchors the wine's palate, where the juicy entry of red plum and blueberry leads to hints of dried orange peel, and is followed by a long finish of cassis, coffee, and cocoa.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON #360

\$160

Cakebread Cellar 2019/ Rutherford, Napa, CA

A classic Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon reveals aromas of ripe blackberry with hints of dark chocolate and sweet oak. On the palate, the dark fruit is balanced by fresh acidity and lush tannins that carry all the way over to a lingering, elegant finish, with just a kiss of minerality.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON #365

\$250

Kinsella Estates "Jersey Boy Vineyard" 2010/ Dry Creek, Sonoma, CA

Ripe blackberry, juicy and rich with a wonderful chocolate core. Each bottle comes with a golf marker. Organically farmed.

SYRAH #370

\$85

Jean-Michel Gerin "La Champine" 2014

Collines Rhodaniennes, Northern Rhône, France

The Syrah brings in smoke, violets, and red fruits. The combination gives the wine a softer entry with underlying power and finesse. Inky ruby with vibrant cherry and black currant aromas are complemented by suggestions of black pepper, violet, and olive. Taut and structured on entry, then more open in the mid-palate, it offers red berry and bitter cherry flavors sweetened by a floral pastille nuance and a hint of cola.
