# French White Wines

## Loire Valley

Located in the north-west corner of France along the Loire River. The driest whites can be found on the outskirts of the region; Muscadet to the far west, home to the slightly salty but very dry wine made from Melon de Bourgogne, and Sancerre and Pouilly-Fumé to the far east, where you'll find flinty smoky styles of Sauvignon Blanc. Towards the center of the valley is the region of Vouvray, making Chenin Blanc in various levels of sweetness.
