**White**

- Pied de Samson, Dom. George Vernay, N. Rhône 2023** 125  
*Viognier* - From a plateau just above Condrieu and just as good, if not better, from a celebrated producer. Honeysuckle bouquet, apricot & mirabelle palate with a dry, elegant finish.
- Bourgogne Aligoté, Maison Meyer, Burgundy 2023** 175  
From ex-banker turned cult winemaker Nikolas Meyer. Tiny allocations make his wines incredibly sought after. A textbook Aligoté showing fresh vibrant citrus fruit, a dash of herbs and a gentle salinity on the surprisingly long finish. Delicious, and ready to go right now.
- Chablis Grand Cru Bougros, Domaine William Fevre, Burgundy 2018** 200  
*Chardonnay* - One of Chablis' greatest wine Domaines, offering a broad & powerful palate.
- Meursault 'Clos de La Velle', Domaine Darviot-Perrin, Burgundy 2023** 210  
*Chardonnay* - A powerful wine, but light on its feet. The fruit is rounded, juicy and lemony, with pear and a hint of hazelnut, and there is gentle breadth to the long saline finish.
- Nuits Saint George Blanc 1er Cru, Clos de L'Arlot, Dom. De L'Arlot, Burgundy 2022** 275  
*Chardonnay* - exactly the combination of concentration, restrained ripeness and elegance that one looks for in high-end white Burgundy. Very long, complete finish. From biodynamically grown grapes. Delicious!

**Red**

- Brunello di Montalcino, Castello Romitorio, Tuscany 2019** 165  
*Sangiovese* - From an ancient Tuscan hilltop fortress rescued in the 1980's by artist Sandro Chia, hail some benchmark Brunello's. Now run by his son Filippo expect intense flavours of dark and red fruits, balanced by earthy and spicy notes like clove, cedar, and herbs, with a full body and refreshing acidity.
- Barolo Cru Paigallo, Casa E. di Mirafiore, Piedmont 2019** 175  
*Nebbiolo* - A winery set up by the first King of Italy's son, notorious throughout the region. Rich, ruby colour, black cherry palate and a velvety, persistent finish
- Côte Rôtie 'La Giroffarie', Dom. Patrick Jasmin, N. Rhône 2021** 175  
*Syrah, Viognier* - The Jasmin wines are noted for benchmark Burgundian finesse and richness, with bouquets of violets and stewed red fruits preceding darker Autumnal fruits on the palate.
- Finca Dofi, Álvaro Palacios, Priorat, Spain 2022** 210  
*Grenache blend* - From one of Spain's most celebrated winemakers, this is a stunning wine with red fruit and lovely aromas of velvety red roses. Vividly fresh palate, with wild herbs overlaying the resounding dark fruits.
- Volnay 1er Cru Clos De Chênes, Dom. Fontaine-Gagnard, Burgundy 2022** 220  
*Pinot Noir* - Densely woven pure red strawberry and lively acidity make up this delicious wine from a third-generation female winemaker.
- Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru, Racine du Temps Très Vieille Vignes, Domaine René Bouvier, Burgundy 2022** 235  
*Pinot Noir* - The nearly one hundred-year-old vines always give a wine of great intensity. Full of black-cherry and blackcurrant fruit, bright energy and a dense long saline-tinged finish.
- Domaine De Trévallon, Alpilles 2012** 295  
*Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon* - A cult favourite and a very elegant vintage. Wild strawberries, low tannins and vibrant freshness.
- Cornas, Dom. Auguste Clape, N. Rhône 2017** 375  
*Syrah* - As classic & old school as they come, and the 2018 is as Clape as it gets with bloody blue fruits, pepper, bay leaf and smoked game on a medium to full bodied palate.
- Ch. Lynch-Bages 5eme Cru Classe, Pauillac 2016** 395  
*Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc* - Monumental in stature, with layer after layer of complex black fruits, stewed, mulled and crunchy. This is a great Lynch, somehow conjuring both power, weight and structure with lightness and freshness.
