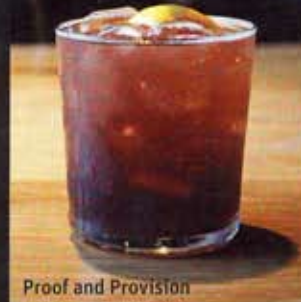
PROOF AND PROVISION

A side entrance for the Georgian Terrace Hotel off Ponce de Leon Avenue leads to this dim, moody bar—the edgy counterpart to Livingston Restaurant and Bar upstairs. The drink list includes a dozen or so wines by the glass or bottle as well as draft beers like Clown Shoes' Clementine white ale, but cocktails are the true draw.
