We're loving the craft cocktail revival, but not the 30 minutes of mixing and muddling it can take to concoct an artisanal drink. We give you **The Pinewood Tippling Room** (pinewoodtr.com) in Decatur, Georgia. This intimate bar has created a draft cocktail program to serve up finely concocted Vespers and Negronis in a jiff without compromising taste. The **Old Fashioned**, made with rye whiskey, bitters, and oleo saccharum, is served daily on tap. Barkeeper T. Fable Jeon

also plays around with specials such as The Day That I Die, a blend of rye, ginger, lemon, Georgia pecans, and buckwheat syrup. "I try and find that greater narrative by using Southern flavors like mayhaw, muscadine, and local honey," Jeon says.
