Our selection is weighted a little heavy in Champagne's favor, but that doesn't mean there aren't great bubbles coming to us from all over the world. We tried to make sure that we included a good mix of selections from everywhere else in the world and the ratio will ebb and flow as we continue to request sample bottles of bubbles for our "educational consumption".

### **Current Favorite:**

La Bruyère Grand Cru Prolouge Brut NV - This grower champagne starts with some of the most sought after grapes in Verzenay, most of which used to go to Dom Perignon. Up front it has bright red fruit flavors and lemon curd, followed by hazelnut and brioche notes. The finish is long and accentuated by tight bubbles. This bottle always overdelivers.

## OREGON AND WASHINGTON

The Pacific Northwest represents a unique combination of diverse soils and micro-climates at a northern latitude. It's proximity to the coastal breezes of the Pacific ocean and the rain shadow effects of the Cascade mountain range, provide winemakers in the region with a vast array of options for their winemaking selections ... and our drinking enjoyment!!

### Current Favorites:

Lingua Franca Bunker Hill **Chardonnay** - The vineyard manager at Bunker Hill is a strong proponent of non-intervention farming, allowing the ecosystem to take care of the vines. This results in an amazing mineral driven wine. Up front you get golden apple and notes of fresh bread, followed by great texture and big mineral tones, and finishing strong with more golden apple flavors.

Racine from Roots **Pinot Noir** - Notice the age on this one, 2012, we held it a little longer to allow the flavors to continue to develop. The gamble paid off, this is a great expression of Oregon Pinot, with co-mingled red cherry, mushroom, and forest floor notes, followed by a medium body, and long slightly floral finish.

## CALIFORNIA

The coastal breezes, ample sunshine, diverse terroir, undulating hills, and rolling valleys create a number of near perfect micro-climates for grape growing throughout the state of California. Fruit driven, immediately approachable, and a clear sense of ripeness, California wines are the epitome of what's referred to as the "New World" style of wine.

### Current Favorites:

Hudson Estate **Chardonnay** - The product of meticulously selected growing sites, vineyard management, and a dedication to producing amazing grapes. This is a rich and full chardonnay, full of ripe apple fruit, minerality, and acidity. From the first sip through the incredibly long finish, this wine stays bright and clean on the palate.

Hourglass HG III **Blend** - An amazing wine from a small family owned winery. Made up of Merlot, Petite Sirah, and Cabernet Sauvignon, this one starts with black fruit and plum before the amazing silky texture takes over, that's followed by vanilla and spice hints and long powerful finish.

French winemaking techniques, and the wine laws of France, have been used as the blueprint for many successful wine producing regions all over the world. Our selections tend to feature our favorite areas - Burgundy, known for its incredible quality pinot noir and chardonnay, Bordeaux, known primarily for its amazing blends centered on cabernet sauvignon and merlot, and the Rhone Valley, known for its GSM (Grenache - Syrah - Mourvedre) blends, earthy syrahs, and terroir driven whites. A true rabbit hole ... you will assuredly never forget your favorite bottle of Gevery-Chambertin, or the first Châteauneuf-du-Pape, or the first left bank Bordeaux you fell in love with ... no time like the present to jump in to the fancy end of the pool and get wet.

### Current Favorites:

Lionel Bussy Premier Cru Côtes de Lechet **Chardonnay** - A rare find and an incredible expression of Chablis and white burgundy. Lemon, mineral, and floral notes on the nose, followed by a chalky robust palate, and finishing with great acidity.

Bosquet des Papes **Grenache Blend** - Châteauneuf-du-Pape wines have long been sought after for their robust palates balanced with opulent fruit and earthy finishes. This one in particular has a great brightness to the front that helps to balance out the big palate and earthy finish.

## ITALY

Italian wines have a unique ability to play well with so many different flavors from all sorts of cuisine from around the world. Italian winemakers have long been known for making the most food-friendly wines anywhere in the world. From easy drinking Valpolicellas, to big Barolos and Super Tuscans, from ever popular Pinot Grigios, and higher acid, mineral driven whites you are sure to find great wines for pairing with any of the dishes on our menu ... or any menu for that matter.

### Current Favorites:

G.D. Vajra **Riesling** - There isn't a lot of Riesling coming out of the Langhe in the Piedmont region so this one has no trouble standing out. It's crisp and clean with white floral notes and lime zest acidity. The finish lingers with the slightest hint of sweetness. Great wine to pair with food!

Elio Altare Barolo **Nebbiolo** - The soils of Barolo lend itself to the Nebbiolo grape perfectly. The wine shows fruit forward hints of red berries, with rose petal, and a touch of tar. Nebbiolo from Barolo shines on the mid-palate where the tannins take center stage. This wine balances a soft, delicate, and elegant demeanor with a robust, and powerful structure.

## SPAIN AND PORTUGAL

Spanish and Portuguese wines provide an exceptional bridge between the New World style and Old World style of winemaking. The whites are known for being crisp, acidic, and mineral driven. While the reds are a good combination of juicy red fruit, big tannins, and earthy undertones. One of the most notable characteristics of Spanish wine is their patience. If you're looking for a great value on vintage wine this could be your region!!

To help demystify the Spanish labels, classifications are as follows:

**Crianza:** wines with a minimum of one year in casks and a few months in the bottle

**Reserva:** wines from the best vintages that have been aged for a minimum of 3 years, at least one year in casks

**Gran Reserva:** wines from exceptional vintages which have spent at least 2 years in oak casks and 3 years in the bottle

### Current Favorites:

Oro de Castilla **Verdejo** - Bright, fresh, and mineral forward. This is a "textbook" verdejo in that it shows exactly what the grape should be.

R. Lopez de Heredia Viña Tondonia Reserva **Tempranillo Blend** - Incredible producer! This reserva starts off with rich red fruit, spice, and herbs. It stays bright in the middle with slowly developing tannins and maintains a great depth throughout. (Don't sleep on their very limited whites!)

Channing Daughters excels at understanding the soils and climates that they are working with and planting the perfect mix of grapes to take advantage. Flavors of citrus, white flowers, peaches, and apples come together with a great texture and long finish.

Decero **Petit Verdot** - Often seen as primarily a blending grape for Bordeaux varietals, this producer decided to highlight what makes it special when grown in the soils of Mendoza. Blue and black fruit and silky textures make this wine easy to enjoy.

## **DIGESTIFS**

For centuries, friars and monks in local abbeys and monasteries all across Europe have been developing health elixirs using aromatic roots and herbs. Many of these tonics possessed a bitter element that when consumed trick the body into kick starting the digestive system in an attempt to expel such a foreign flavor. There is no better way to alleviate that heavy feeling after a large meal.

We “organized” these spirits into three very loose categories. The “Sweeter Side” will have a little more residual sugar than the other two categories, slightly softening the blow from the bitter finish. The “Herbaceous” category will be herb or root forward, these digestifs and amari represent a good middle of the road. The “Bitter Side” is just that, they are herbaceous and bold, with a significant bitterness to the finish.

Many of our guests have been introduced to our “House Wine” the infamous Fernet Branca ... it might not be the best starting point for your blossoming adventure with bitter and herbaceous liquers, but we still encourage you to try one ... or two, or three ... for the sake of science and medicine of course.
