127 — JP Chenet Blanc de Blancs Brut — Côtes de Gascogne, France NV — 30

A French sparkling wine made with 100% Chardonnay grapes.

105 — Santa Marina Prosecco DOC — Treviso, Veneto, Italy 2023 — 42

Fresh and approachable with pear, white peach, citrus, and soft floral aromatics.

107 — Schramsberg “Mirabelle” Brut — California NV — 65

From the historic 19th century Napa caves revived in the 1960's, Schramsberg was the first American winery to use Chardonnay in sparkling wine. This is a refined California sparkler with crisp apple, lemon curd, brioche, and lively acidity. From Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes.

Champagne

104A — Dom Pérignon Brut — Épernay, France 2008 — 525

Dom Pérignon only declares a vintage in years where the harvest meets their strict quality standards. Every bottle bears the year the grapes were harvested. 2008 vintage features complex aromas of white flowers, citrus, stone fruit, crushed mint, and a touch of aniseed. On the palate, it is elegant, mineral-driven, and highly structured with a savory, smoky finish. Powerful and deeply layered with citrus, toasted brioche, almond, mineral tension, and remarkable length.

Crouttes-sur-Marne, France 2019 — 138**

Biodynamic grower Champagne offering orchard fruit, baked apple, spice, and a textured, vinous finish.

128A — Piper-Heidsieck Cuvée Brut — Reims, France NV — 90

Blended from over 100 crus across Pinot Noir, Meunier, and Chardonnay. Energetic with stone fruit, citrus zest, toasted brioche, and persistent bubbles.

121 — Pommery Brut Royal Magnum- Reims, France NV — 200

106A — Veuve Clicquot Rosé Brut — Reims, France NV — 169

Rich and expressive with raspberry, cherry, brioche, and signature Champagne structure.

114 — Voirin-Jumel Grand Cru Blanc de Blancs Brut — Cramant, France NV — 130

Elegant Chardonnay-driven Champagne with lemon zest, chalky minerality, white flowers, and fine bubbles.

Pinot Grigio / Pinot Gris

- 305 — The Eyrie Vineyards Pinot Gris — Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2022 — 50

A benchmark Oregon Pinot Gris from the first Pinot gris vines planted in the New World 50 years ago. Organic, made with minimal human intervention. Notes of ripe melon, beeswax, noheyed citrus, tarragon and savory we stones.
- 302A — Hugel Pinot Gris — Riquewihr, Alsace, France 2020 — 50

Hugel & Fils, founded in 1639 in picturesque Riquewihr, Alsace, France. Hints of more mature fruit: fig, apricot, pear and the more typical notes of noble wood, waxed furniture and undergrowth that will add further to its complexity.
- 300 — Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio — Alto Adige DOC, Italy 2024 — 78

Crisp and clean with bright citrus, green apple, and delicate floral notes. A classic, refreshing Northern Italian expression.
- 303 — La Fiera Pinot Grigio — Delle Venezie DOC, Italy 2024 — 48

Light-bodied and easy-drinking, offering fresh lemon, melon, and subtle mineral character.

Made by the infamous Master Sommelier Christopher Bates, small production in the Finger Lakes of New York. Low alcohol, higher acid, balanced with a focus on mineral and aromas. This is an aged Riesling with developed notes of citrus peel, petrol, stone fruit, and mineral-driven freshness.
- 462 — Georg Breuer "Sauvage" Riesling — Rheingau, Germany 2020 — 55

Organic and certified green, from the Rheingau. The crispy acid structure is balanced with great juiciness. The name "Sauvage" describes the lively, fresh character. Woman owned and operated.

An estate from the 1700's. Organic. Bright and focused with lime, peach, herbal notes, and crisp acidity.

A historic producer since 1641. From an exclusive vineyard characterized by calcareous loam and shell limestone soils. Notes of stone fruit, citrus oil, floral aromatics, and pronounced minerality.

256 — Bodegas Garzón Pinot Noir Rosé — Uruguay 2022 — 50

An impressive winery in Uruguay. Grenache, Cinsaut and Mouvedre were harvested and vinified at the same time, resulting in a fresh and fruity wine with notes of cherries and flowers. Pale pink and excellent! Organic.

A legendary Provençal wine renowned for its unique, Sherry-like aging process under fleurette in 100 year old oak foudres. 90% Tibouren grapes & 10% Grenache. A Cru Classé. One of the most individual, original, and characterful rose wines in the wine world

Aromatic and textured with citrus peel, apricot, white tea, and subtle floral spice.

An ancient grape from Santorini. The vines grow in the ash-rich volcanic soil close to the ground in basket shaped nests. Minerally, crisp, dry. Delicate floral notes, lemon, stony minerality.

495A — Gérard Bertrand Picpoul de Pinet — Pinet, France 2023 — 40

Best when very chilled! An ancient white wine grape from Southern France known for its refreshing, "lip-stinging" acidity. Often bottled as Picpoul de Pinet, this crisp, zesty wine pairs perfectly with seafood. Light-to-medium-bodied and bone-dry refreshing with citrus, green apple, and lively coastal minerality.

471 — Lucien Albrecht Gewürztraminer — Alsace, France 2019 — 55

Off-dry, highly aromatic white wine from Alsace. It features signature notes of lychee, peach, and sweet spices, making it an excellent pairing for spicy cuisine. Soft texture.

488 — La Fiera Moscato — Pavia, Italy NV — 42

Lightly sparkling and sweet. Fragrant with peach, orange blossom, and delicate bubbles.

494A — Tornatore Carricante — Etna, Sicily, Italy 2023 — 75

A highly acclaimed, mineral-driven wine crafted from 100% Carricante grapes grown on the volcanic slopes of Mount Etna, Sicily. We love this one!

489 — Barboursville Vineyards "Reserve" Viognier — Barboursville, Virginia 2022 — 47

A historic Virginia estate and vineyard outside of Charlottesville, home to Virginia's most honored winery founded in 1821. Producer of Octagon, the most renowned red wine of Virginia. Aged in stainless as opposed to the Rhone's traditional method for fermenting and aging Viognier in oak. Juicy and bright pear, passion fruit, and hints of citrus on a gently herbal frame.

It combines Sea Smoke richness with real lift, minerality, and precision. The most classic, rich California Pinot of the three vintages we have. Rich, polished, mature, notes of boysenberry, black raspberry, dark cherry. Velvety tannins. Fully entering peak now!

524 — Sea Smoke “Ten” — Santa Rita Hills, Santa Barbara, California 2016 — 328
The 2016 Sea Smoke “Ten” is a very different animal from Southing.“Ten” is the powerhouse cuvée — darker, denser, more oak-influenced. It’s made from all ten Pinot clones planted on the estate and sees more new French oak.
