

welcome to the tribeca grill. our award winning wine list is arranged by grape variety and then region. the list is international with a focus on burgundy, california and the rhône. many vertical listings of california wines have come directly from the producers.

our châteauneuf du pape selection is the largest in the world. we feel these wines are among the best values in the market today. often produced from old, low yielding vines, the wines have concentrated and complex flavors that complement the robust cuisine that tribeca grill is known for.

all of our wines are kept in temperature-controlled cellars at 58 degrees. some, including most red wines, may need a few minutes to warm up in the glass once they are opened. we have the utmost confidence in our suppliers of these wines, however they are presented in "as is" condition. please understand that there can be bottle variation with wines that have been aged for long periods of time.
