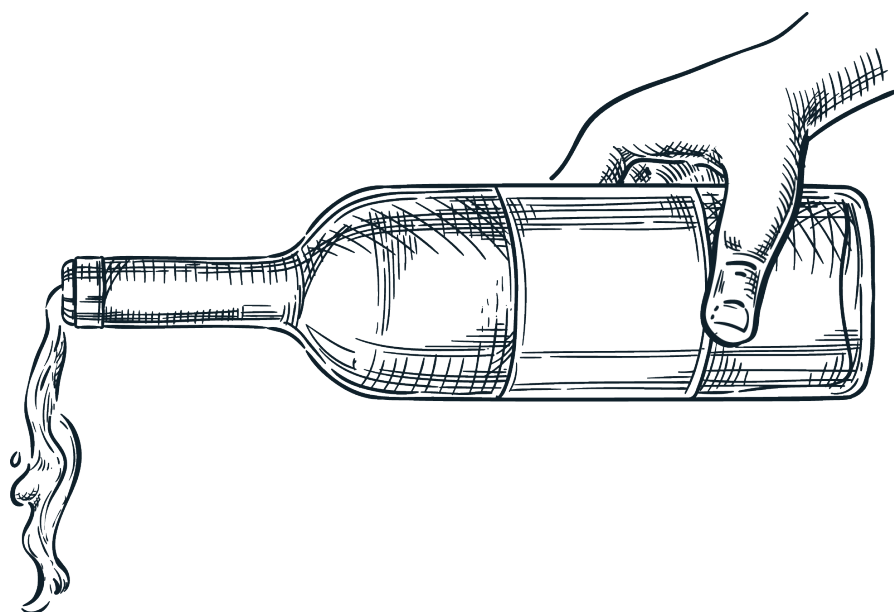

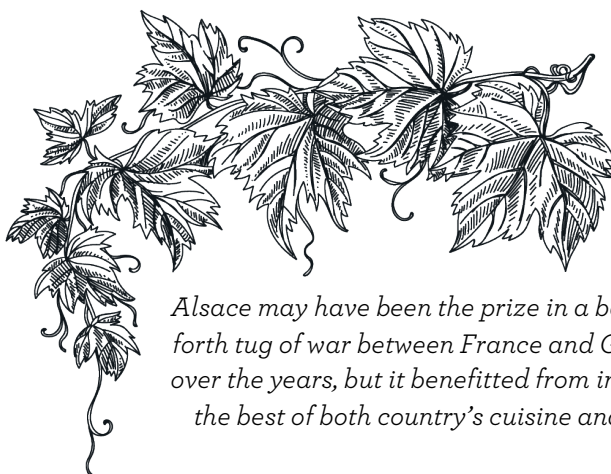

Oak barrels have been used in winemaking since the height of the Roman Empire. Wood, being porous, allows for water and alcohol to evaporate out of the wine, creating more concentrated flavors. It also allows a small amount of oxygen to mix with the wine creating a softer taste. Chardonnay comes in many different stages of oak, from completely unoaked, to so heavy it's like drinking sap from a tree.

Aotearoa (Land of the Long White Cloud) is the Maori name for New Zealand. While the Kiwis are known worldwide for their sauvignon blanc, the grape barely existed on the archipelago until the 1970s. Similarly, the New Zealand national rugby team, known as the “All Blacks” were founded in 1893. They too are now the gold standard across the globe, not for their grapefruit forward wine, but for their quality on the pitch and more recognizably their pre-match war dance, the Haka.

The Russian River Valley has a characteristically cool climate, heavily affected by fog generated by the valley's proximity to the Pacific Ocean. The area is known for its success with cool climate varietals, notably the thin-skinned Pinot Noir. RRV consists of 70 vineyards spanning over 15,000 planted acres.

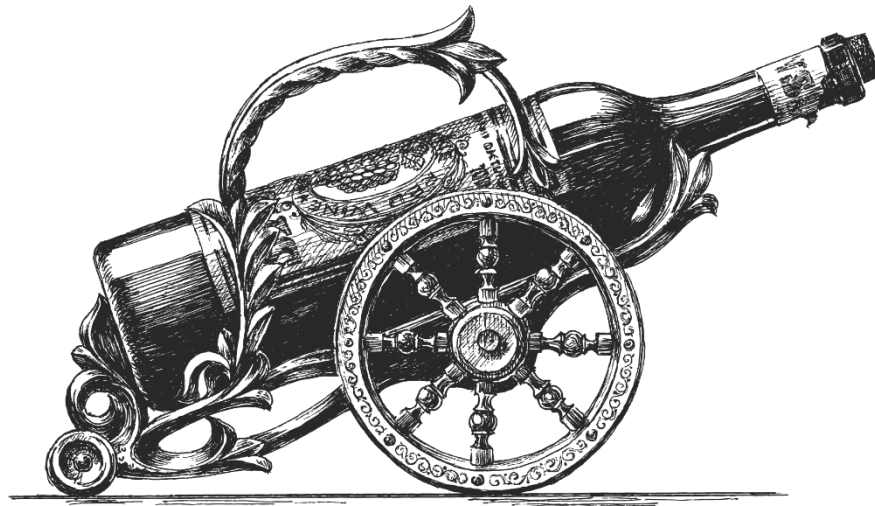

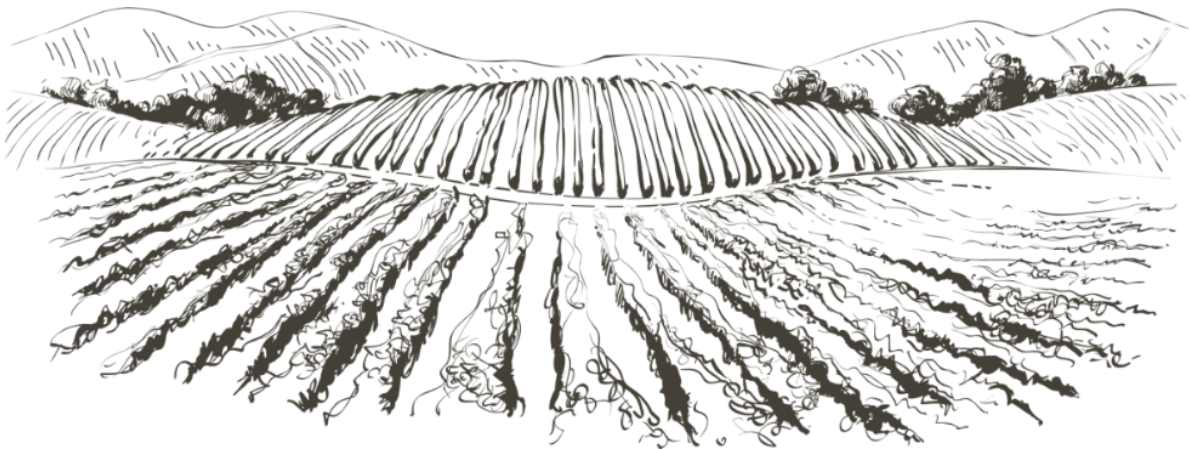

In the late 1960s, while attending the University of California at Davis, Christian Moueix fell in love with the Napa Valley and its wines. Son of Jean-Pierre Moueix, the famed wine merchant and producer from Libourne, France, Moueix returned home in 1970 to manage the family vineyards, including Chateaux Petrus, La Fleur-Petrus, Trotanoy in Pomerol and Magdelaine in Saint Emilion.

His love of Napa Valley lingered and, in 1981, he discovered the historic Napanook Vineyard, a 124-acre site west of Yountville that had been the source of fruit for some of the finest Napa Valley wines of the 1940s and 1950s. In 1982, Moueix entered a partnership to develop the vineyard and, in 1995, became its sole owner. He chose the name 'Dominus' or 'Lord of the Estate' in latin to underscore his longstanding commitment to stewardship of the land.
