10 New Outdoor Dining Spaces in NYC for Summer 2016

While it may not feel like it just yet, we're right around the corner from prime outdoor dining season. To help get you up to speed for 2016, here are 10 new hot spots for alfresco eating and imbibing.



Pig Beach

Opening May 26, the 150-seat outdoor Gowanus eatery returns this year with an all-star culinary team. The barbecue team behind Salty Rinse and Ribdiculous Bar-B-Krewe, made up of partners Shane McBride (**Balthazar**), Ed McFarland (**Ed's Lobster Bar**), Matt Abdoo (**Del Posto**) bring their award-winning signature meats to Pig Beach. Look for their championship baby back ribs, homemade sausage, and a brisket and short rib burger. To drink, select from frozen cocktails like the Siesta (tequila, Campari, lime and grapefruit), rose wine on tap, and craft beers from Other Half and Brooklyn Brewery among others. The 13,000 square-foot space on the waterfront features picnic tables, corn hole, ping pong, string lighting and high-top tables.
