Reviving the nightlife space within W South Beach for a seasonal residency, **Mary Lou's Miami** brings a new era of nostalgic nightlife to Miami Beach. Mary Lou's co-founders Joe Cervasio, Topher Grubb and Alex Melillo have joined forces with Jamie Reuben of real estate group Reuben Brothers to breathe new life into the iconic space. The Mary Lou's team tapped Jason Volence to reimagine the space, fusing the brand's signature surrealist visual identity with the kind of seductive glamour synonymous with Miami Beach. Drenched in animal print, rich patterns and lush textures, this takeover blurs the lines between reverie and reality. mary-lous.com

EAT HERE NOW

Ezio's is the highly anticipated Miami restaurant from the team behind New York's iconic Roberta's. Co-owners Brandon Hoy and Carlo Mirarchi have brought their celebrated culinary vision to Miami's North Beach neighborhood at the new luxury condominium tower 72 Park. Ezio's menu showcases raw bar selections featuring locally sourced seafood, an array of house-made pastas and a custom dry-aging program. Raw bar selections showcase coastal offerings, including stone crab claws and wild-caught fin fish crudo. Housemade pastas like linguine cacio e pepe with winter truffle and pappardelle with braised veal and parmigiano reggiano take center stage on the menu. The rich space has elements of a steakhouse with dark wood, veined stone, velvet and warm lighting. eziosmiami.com



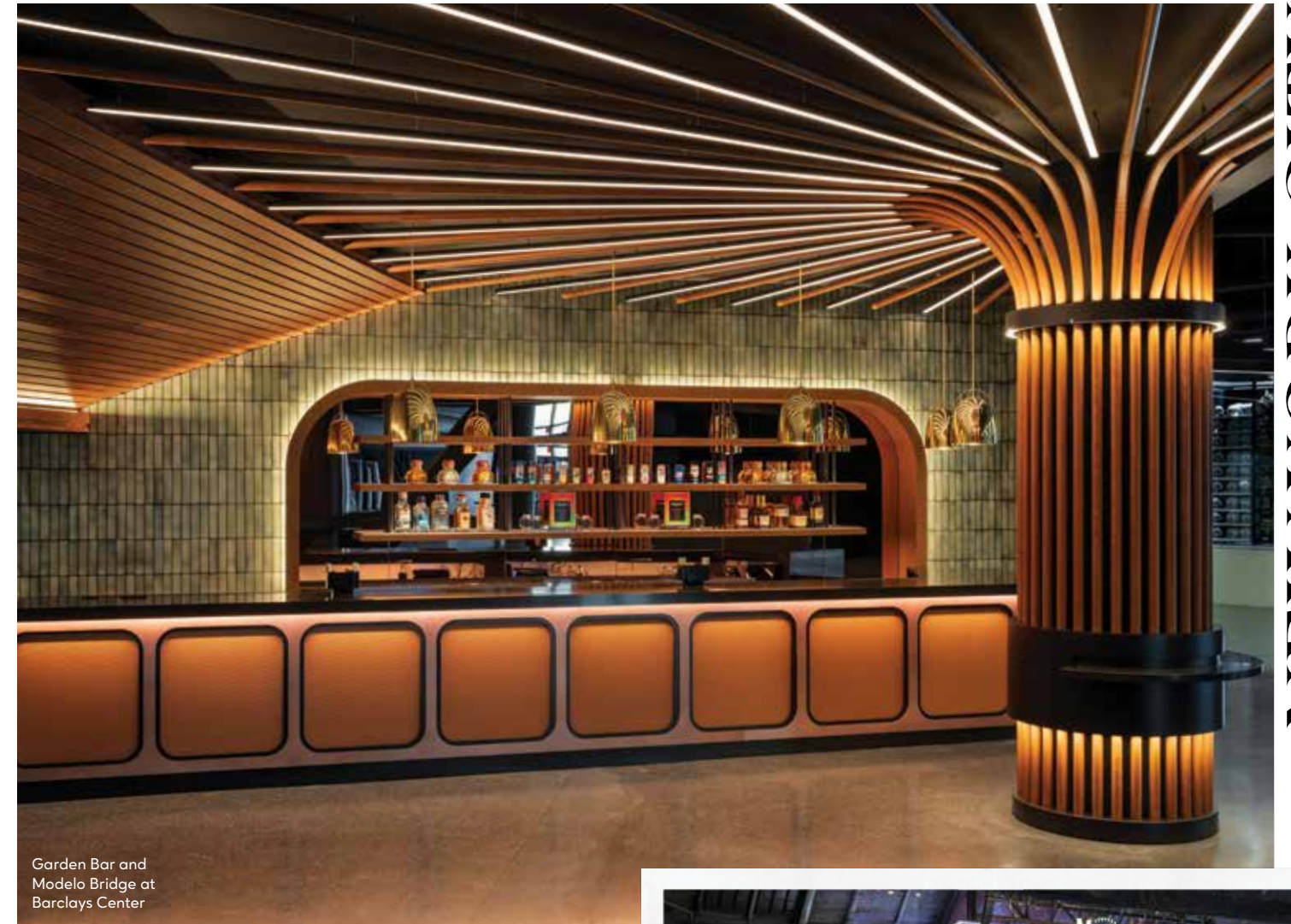

Bella is an Italian restaurant by chef Eyal Shani that celebrates southern Italy at the Liberty Park Hotel (formerly South Beach Hotel). Salads, vegetable mezze, seafood, meats and handmade pastas anchor the menu along with Italian favorites like fritto misto and branzino. The space evokes the leisurely spirit of an Italian palazzo, centered around a vintage artichoke fountain reminiscent of Naples' Fontana del Carciofo. The courtyard's vibrant greenery blends seamlessly with terra-cotta floors, limestone accents, custom-made furniture, hand-blown glass lamps, soft sage-green tones and subtle striped upholstery. bellamiami.com

CLUB LIFE

New premium spaces have opened at **Barclays Center** as part of the arena's five-year, \$100 million enhancement plan. Loge boxes and sections of the 40/40 Club have been transformed into Gallagher Terrace, a 5,300-square-foot space exclusive to 110 guests. The intimate club is the only area in Barclays Center to offer an in-seat dining experience with game views and waiter service, along with a full-service bar with premium wines and a team of sommeliers. The west end of Barclays Center's upper concourse has been reimaged as **Modelo Bridge**, a two-level, 6,800-square-foot multi-use space designed as both a communal destination open to all guests and an activation zone for halftime performances, fan contests and other entertainment. **Modelo Bridge** features an oversized raised platform shaped like a bridge, inspired by the iconic structures



connecting Brooklyn to the rest of New York, complete with artwork from local New York muralists commissioned in partnership with the Mexican beer brand. Guests can enjoy unobstructed views from two standing-room decks, purchase drinks from the arena's largest bar and take in views of Downtown Brooklyn through panoramic windows. barclayscenter.com

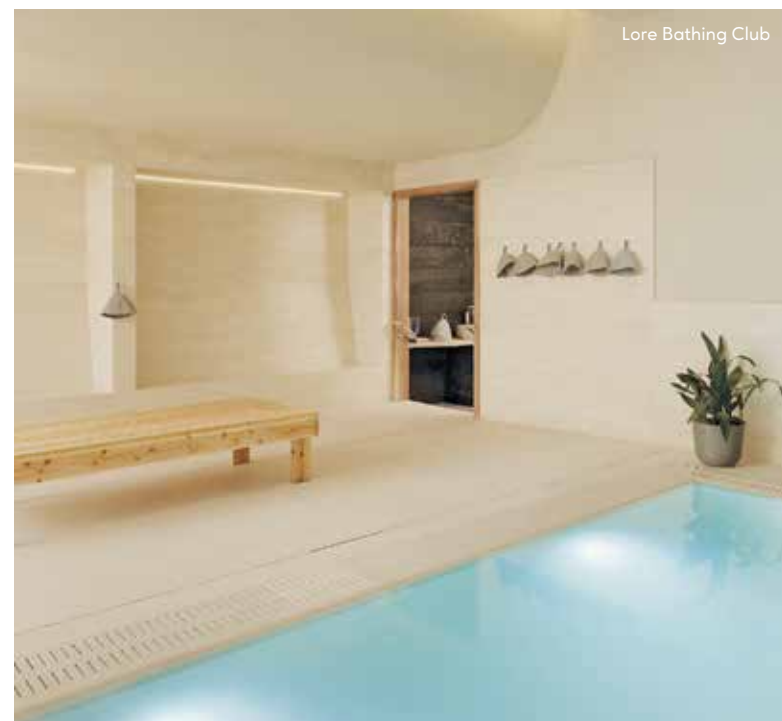

Spotless seeks to eliminate the trial-and-error cycle of products, influencers and home remedies, meeting people at every stage of their skin journey. Spotless offers same-day, medical-grade treatments—from pimple shots to acne peels and extractions—by nurse practitioners trained by Dr. Wechsler. Spotless was born from the shared mission of mother-daughter duo Amy and Zoe to reimagine acne care, offering walk-in treatments such as pimple shots, extractions and chemical peels in a modern, approachable setting designed for real life. spotlessclinics.com

Lore Bathing Club in NoHo is a new wellness space rooted in the rich heritage of bathing culture reimagined for contemporary life by entrepreneurs James O'Reilly (NeueHouse and Life Time) and Adam Elzer (Everyday Hospitality). Lore boasts 6,200 square feet over two floors and showcases saunas (infrared and dry heat) and a cold pool. Embracing the intensity of the heat and the discomfort of the cold is a deeply primal experience. "While it's been around for millennia, science now confirms what tradition always knew: regular sauna and cold water immersion sessions enrich health," says O'Reilly. "The key isn't longer sessions but greater frequency." This insight inspired Lore, a neighborhood bathing club designed for those committed to a regular practice. The interiors are intentionally designed to guide the body through a sensory journey of bathing via a carefully sequenced palette of materials and textures like travertine, textured floors, alder wood and deep chocolate tones mirroring the body's movement between hot and cold. lorebathingclub.com

EAT HERE NOW

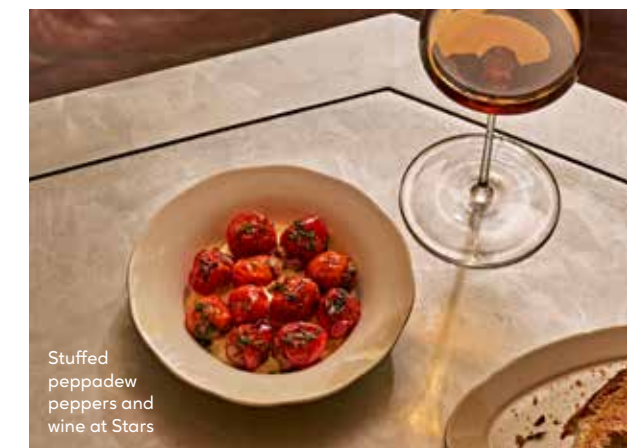
Situated along Dumbo's historic waterfront across from Jane's Carousel and St. Ann's Warehouse theater, with views of the Brooklyn and Manhattan Bridges, **ABC Kitchens** is the next evolution of the ABC experience. Chef Jean-Georges Vongerichten first introduced ABC Kitchen in 2010, followed by ABC Cocina in 2013 and abcV in 2017. In Dumbo, the new restaurant's seasonally driven menu brings together the best of the trio: from ABC Kitchen's approach to farmers market fare to abcV's innovative plant-based dishes and ABC Cocina's Latin flavors. Menu highlights include favorites from the three restaurants such as the peekytoe crab toast, dosas, arroz con pollo and the caramel popcorn sundae. The space, designed by JGV president and co-CEO Lois Freedman, features a glass-enclosed inner room that houses a shoppable collection of vintage glassware and a floral atelier by day and serves as a private dining room by night. abckitchensdumbo.com

Stars is an intimate wine bar earning acclaim as a destination for serious wine enthusiasts and casual sippers alike. The 450-square-foot space in New York City's East Village, designed by Studio Valle de Valle, is wrapped in brushed cedar panels, cast under the warm glow of a skylight-like ceiling light fixture with matte marbled floors. Anchoring the jewel box space is a hand-finished, horseshoe-shaped zinc bar outfitted with custom mahogany stools. Stars comes from Chase Sinzer and Joshua Pinsky, the team behind Claud and Penny. A delicious assortment of small bites such as deviled eggs with pommes soufflées, marinated vegetables with chorizo and a griddled shrimp toast are not to be missed—nor is the butterscotch pudding for dessert. stars-ny.com
