THE GRAPES FOR THIS WINE COME FROM HIGH-ELEVATION VINEYARDS IN THE ATLAS PEAK AVA, INCLUDING THE RENOWNED STAGECOACH VINEYARD. CHARACTERIZED BY ROCKY, VOLCANIC, AND SHALLOW SOIL THIS RUGGED TERRAIN OFFERS THE PERFECT COMBINATION OF ELEMENTS FOR CULTIVATING HIGH-QUALITY CABERNET SAUVIGNON. THE WINE IS NAMED AFTER BOTH THE PEAK AND THE MYTHICAL GREEK FIGURE, ATLAS, WHO CARRIED THE WEIGHT OF THE WORLD ON HIS SHOULDERS. THIS METAPHOR PERFECTLY CAPTURES THE FLESHY AND WEIGHTY CHARACTER OF ATLAS PEAK WINES, OFFERING A RICH AND ROBUST TASTING EXPERIENCE.
