[The Watermark](#) brings Oktoberfest right into the city with skyline views surrounding the festival on Pier 15. This open-air Oktoberfest has oodles of authentic German beer, including 5-liter kegs for purchase, a range of flavorful bratwurst and pretzels, and fun decor and games.

All ages are welcome and reservations are encouraged, as it can get crowded. If you can't secure a table, they also have standing room admission.

I went to this Oktoberfest, and the food and beer were delicious. The skyline views of Brooklyn and Williamsburg bridges cannot be beat. You will have a solid experience, but it isn't necessarily as authentic as other Oktoberfests held in traditional beer gardens.
