## THE BEST ENCLOSED BARS FOR FALL IN NYC

Sure, summer is the obvious choice for rooftop bar imbibing, but the change of seasons needn't downscale your drinking options. New York City has plenty of enclosed, covered, and heated rooftop spots where you can sip among the clouds throughout fall, well into winter, and, someday, spring.

This is the time of year when we trade swimming pools for fireplaces, frozés for hot toddys, and summer Fridays for “wow it's already dark out when I leave work” everyday. Autumn's crisp air, beautiful foliage, and cozy sweaters come with certain superficial sacrifices, but your elevated cocktail, wine, and beer consumption needn't be one of them. Here is everywhere you can enjoy outdoor-adjacent views and booze this fall and beyond.

### **MR. PURPLE**

#### *LOWER EAST SIDE*

This 15th-floor lounge plays to the Lower East Side going-out crowd with cocktails carbonated and bottled in-house, punches made with small-batch spirits, and Irving Roasters coffee to keep partiers awake throughout the night. When it's not pool weather, views are best enjoyed on the indoor chaise lounges, banquettes, and high-top communal tables, where you can also order grilled cheese, franks in a blanket, or kale Caesar salad (naturally).
