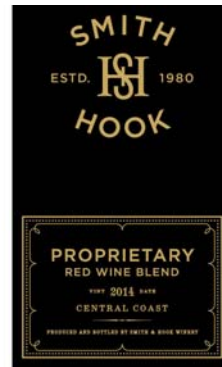
Lieu Dit Sauvignon Blanc 2016

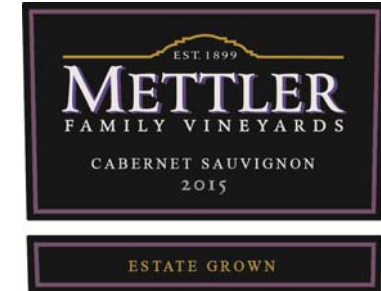
Smith & Hook Red Blend 2014

26% Petite Sirah, 2% Cabernet
Aged: 26 Months French Oak

Mettler Cabernet Sauvignon 2015

Appellation: Lodi
Varietals: 88% Cabernet, 12% Petite Sirah
Aged: 16 Months French Oak

"It opens with inviting aromas of dark cherry, cola, cedar, mineral and earth. The graceful mingling of cherry, cranberry and sweet oak flavors have a freshness of character and a whisper of vanilla. On the palate, the rich mouthfeel is moderated by juicy acidity, and the long finish is reminiscent of a fine Bordeaux."
