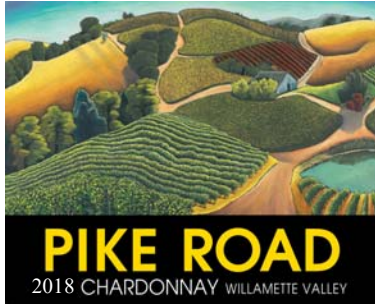


Wines from the Pacific Northwest

Appellation: Willamette Valley, Oregon
Varietals: 100% Chardonnay
Aged: 2/3 Stainless Steel, 1/3 Oak

"The wine has aromas and flavors of apple, pear and tropical fruit with a lightly oaked profile and supple texture."

Aged: 8-10 Month in French Oak

"This wine delivers with fresh red fruit flavors, like raspberry and ripe strawberry. There are definitive Oregon flavors of mushroom, forest floor and earth. This is rich and well-built with oak and vanilla nuances attributed to aging in French oak."

"The Spellbinder" 2017**
Appellation: Columbia Valley, WA
Varietals: 43% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Cab Franc 10% Merlot, 5% Syrah
Aged: Oak Aging

"Our 2017 Spellbinder is dramatically aromatic, with classic Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc herb and earth notes framed by graphite overtones. It is a medium-bodied wine showing both red and dark fruit characteristics, including bing cherry, blueberry, and cassis, that finishes with soft tannins and bright acid."
