Deriving its predominant flavor from juniper berries, gin is one of the broadest categories of spirit. From its earliest origins in the Middle Ages, the drink has evolved from an herbal medicine to an object of commerce in the spirits industry. Gin was developed based on the older Flemish liquor, genever, and became popular in Great Britain the late 1600s.

TEQUILA

AROUT

Tequila, originating in the 16th century, is an agave-based distilled spirit produced around Tequila, Jalisco. Blanco tequila, also known as Silver or Plata tequila, is the purest form of tequila. It's unaged or aged for a short period (less than 2 months), and is bottled immediately after distillation, resulting in a clear, agave-forward spirit. Reposado teguila, is aged in oak barrels for 2-12 months, imparting a smoother, more mellow flavor with notes of vanilla, caramel, and subtle spices. Añejo tequila is aged in oak barrels for at least one year, but no more than three years. This aging process imparts a darker color and more complex, rich flavors, such as vanilla, caramel, and oak, to the tequila.

ABOUT LIQUORS

Rum, rhum and cachaça all hail from sugercane but have distinctive production methods and flavor profiles. Rum, widespread in the Caribbean and Latin America, uses molasses or sugarcane juice, resulting in a diverse array of styles with notes ranging from bold to refined. Rhum, like French rhum agricole from places like Martinique and Guadeloupe, distinguishes itself by using fresh sugarcane juice, giving it a unique grassy and vegetal character. Cachaça, Brazil's pride, primarily relies on fresh sugarcane juice and offers a vibrant and fruity profile, commonly enjoyed in the Caipirinha cocktail.


CORDIALS VERMOUTH

Aperitivo: A pre-dinner tradition and light, slightly bitter drinks in Italy, like Aperol Spritz and Campari with soda.

Vermouth: Fortified wine infused with herbs and spices, available as sweet (red) and dry (white), used in cocktails or sipped straight.

Cordial: Sweet and flavored liqueurs made by infusing base spirits with various flavors, used in cocktails or desserts.
