LA KIUVA VALLE D'AOSTA ROSÉ DE VALLÉE

the region | Vallée d'Aosta
the producer | La Kiuva

Northern Italy is home to many tiny plots of vineyards and small wine producers. In Vallée d'Aosta, a group of 60 farmers have gathered together to create wines from their small plots - now known as La Kiuva. Created in 1975 in the village of Pied de Ville, La Kiuva was formed to give more leverage to smaller wine producers in the region and have their wines reach more people! They farm organically, with each farmer focusing on their individual plot and a the cooperative's agronomist overseeing the operation so that grapes are of the highest quality. The "Kiuva" refers to a bale of chestnut leaves used to feed animals in the winter..

the wine | Valle d'Aosta Rosé de
Vallée

A blend of Nebbiolo, Gros Vien, and Neyret (all Italian varieties, with one being a bit more popular than the others), this rosé is meant to be enjoyed with a summery dish - and with asparagus season upon us, now is the perfect time to enjoy! The grapes were grown on high elevation, giving them a bright acidity backed with fresh fruit aromas and flavors - raspberry, strawberries, and wild berries galore.
