*Italian culture is synonymous with flavor, glamour, speed, and artistry. When the first wave of Italian immigrants arrived in Manhattan, a blending of traditions forever changed New York's cultural identity. It is this lasting impression that our wine list hopes to serve: a tribute that is truly Italian-American.*

*In a building that was once at the heart of an Italian immigrant neighborhood, the One Fifth wine cellar embraces the best of both winemaking regions, while highlighting their intertwined viticultural history. In the 19th and 20th centuries, American technology helped modernize the Italian wine industry. Meanwhile, many of the first wave of Italian immigrants moved west to populate California, bringing vines and winemaking experience to the West Coast. As is clear by the profusion of vowel-ending names, several of these "Cal-Ital" enterprises are still recognized today: Mondavi, Sebastiani, Pietro Carlo Rossi, Gallo, and Martinelli.*

*Whether it be through a glass of Carricante from Sonoma Coast or a perfectly prepared bowl of Rigatoni, we love celebrating the modern-day Italian-American experience. Our wine list contains selections from some of the most iconic Italian and American wine producers today. The listed grape variety will be your roadmap for general style, structure, and flavor but there will always be a few unconventional surprises along the way.*

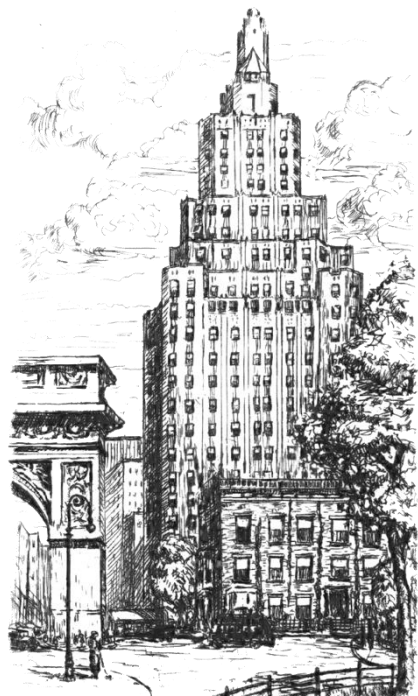

*"If anyone orders Merlot, I'm leaving." In the 1990s, and until the movie Sideways punctured its reputation, Merlot was regarded as 'the hot variety' in the Cabernet-soaked state of California, demonstrating decisively that it had a particular affinity with the conditions of Washington. While California offers up plusher, softer styles, Washington state Merlot reveals structure and earthiness, rarely found in other parts of the country. 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# VINTAGE AMARI

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## **Ali, FA-LI-STEF, Piedmont 1970's 21% 20**

Ali was founded by Guiseppe "Ali" Aliberti in the town of Canelli in the province of Asti in the 1950's. Today they are owned and operated by Giuseppe's great grandchildren. Their specialty was (and still is) grappa, but for a short time in the 1970s they also produced this (now discontinued) amaro. The name is Piedmontese dialect for the classic response to a bartender asking, "What'll you have?" - "Fa-Li-Stef," "the usual."

## **Alpestre Riserva Speciale, Piedmont 1960's 49.5% 40**

Its origins trace back to Hermitage, France in 1857 when it was called "Arquebuse dell'Hermitage." The French government sent it to soldiers to be used as a first aid remedy for those injured in battle by the "arquebus" guns. It wasn't until 1904 when it made its way to Turin, Italy that the priests moved to outside Turin and named the new distillery San Giuseppe Alpestre. The spirit is distilled from 34 aromatic herbs and aged for 10 years in Slovenian oak, then bottled without sugar or additional additives before being aged 10 years prior to release.

## **Averna, Sicily 1990's 32% 25**

Averna was first produced at home by Salvatore Averna in 1868, in the town of Caltanissetta, Sicily using a recipe gifted to him as a token of gratitude from the church. In 1895 he gifted some of his elixir to King Umberto I, and in 1912 Vittorio Emanuele III granted Averna's family the right to use the royal crest on their label. Upon Salvatore's passing his wife took over production, making her one of the first women to oversee an Italian company. Today it is distilled by infusing the herbs in a neutral grain spirit prior to diluting, sweetening, and aging it for 18 months.

## **Bergia Rabarbaro, Piedmont 1960's 18% 35**

Rabarbaro Bergia was one of the flagship liqueurs of the Bergia family distillery, founded in Turin in 1870. Originally known as the "barbarian infusion," the recipe takes 12 years to produce and has remained unchanged over the years.

## **Buton Amaro Felsina, Emilia-Romagna 1960's 30% 40**

Jean Buton moved to Emilia-Romagna from Charentes, France in 1820 to build upon his family's legacy of French distillation. Over the years the distillery has produced brandy, gin, and countless other spirits and liqueurs - including this discontinued amaro.

## **Bràulio Riserva Speciale, Lombardy 2018 24.7% 25**

One of the textbook expressions of amaro Alpino comes from the Valtellina region of Lombardy, where the Pelsoni family has been producing it since 1826. Today production is overseen by Francesco's great grand-nephew Edoardo Tarantola Pelsoni, while his brother oversees the family's local pharmacy. It is still produced by hand with herbs and botanicals from the surrounding Mt. Bràulio, and aged for 24 months in small Slovenian oak barrels (vs 15 for the regular bottling).

## **Camatti Umberto Briganti, Liguria 1960's/70's 20% 30**

This amaro was first made by Umberto Briganti in 1923, and named for his wife. The bitters were originally prepared by the local pharmacist and prescribed for their healing properties. The commercial distillery was established in 1964 in village of Monterosso al Mare, one of the five villages of Liguria's famed Cinque Terre coastline. Today the distillery is run by Stefano Bergamino and Camilla Moggia, who carry on the family tradition.

# VINTAGE AMARI

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## **Cynar, Veneto**

The most famous elixir on the planet, Cynar is made with artichoke thistles (*Cynara Scolymus*) and 12 other herbs and plants. It was created in 1949 by Antonio Dalla Molle, and first commercially produced in 1952 in Padua. The 1970s marketing campaign still holds true today: *“sip against the wear and tear of modern life.”*

## **Cinzano Amaro Savoia Liqueur, Piedmont 1950's 38.5% 42**

Known predominantly for their vermouths, Cinzano was founded by two brothers in 1757. This rare amaro is inspired by the alpine herbs and digestivos from neighboring Switzerland.

## **Dom/Don Bairo Elisir Amaro, Piedmont**

With an original recipe dating back to 1452, Dom Bairo is a wine based amaro (or *uvamaro*) created by doctor Pietro Bairo and produced in Canale d'Alba. Originally called D.O.M. (Deo Optimo Maximo), in 1974 it was abbreviated to simply Dom Bairo until production ceased in the mid 90's. According to the good doctor (and the back label), “the moderate use will give more and healthier consolation and good humor.”

## **Fratelli Branca Distillerie, Lombardy**

While not the original fernet, it is undisputedly the most recognized and the flagship spirit of the distillery. Its origins date back to 1845 when it was first produced in Milan by Bernardino Branca, with commercial production beginning in 1862. The secret recipe consists of 27 Botanicals including gentian root, aloe, saffron, chamomile, cinnamon, rhubarb, cinchona, zedoary, galangal, linden, iris, bitter orange, saffron, and myrrh. It is aged for 1 year in oak prior to release. Inspired by Greek opera singer Maria Callas who used to enjoy her Fernet Branca with mint, “Fernet Branca alla menta” was introduced in 1965. The Elisir China is a rare and discontinued amaro based on cinchona bark which was used to create quinine and treat malaria.

## **Lucano, Basilicata, 1980's 30% 40**

Hailing from the small town of Pisticci in Matera, Italy, Amaro Lucano dates back to 1894 when pastry chef Pasquale Vena created this iconic tincture of 30 herbs in the back of his biscuit factory. In the words of the 70's TV commercials, “*Casa vuoi di piú della vita?*” “*What else do you want from life?*” – *A Lucano!*

## **Meletti Anisetta, Marche 1940's 21% 55**

The Meletti family has been producing amaro since 1870. Today the distillery is in the hands of 5<sup>th</sup>-generation owners Mauro and Matteo. The anisetta is produced using Silvio Meletti's original recipe from 1870 using local green anise from Le Marche. It is distilled in a bain marie to increase the aromatics before being blended with herbs and distilled again.

# VINTAGE AMARI

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## **Nonino, Friuli**

Hailing from Udine in Northeastern Italy, the Nonino family has been one of the country's premier grappa houses since 1897. In 1984 they produced the first UE Vitigni Bianchi and had to petition for permission to distill the entire grape. In this case they used Friulian grape varieties such as Ribolla Gialla, Moscato, and Malvasia. The Quintessentia Amaro was first released in 1992, a blend of grape distillate that is infused with thyme, quinine bark, gentian, root, and wormwood. It is aged for 12 months in small barriques from Nevers, Limousin and ex-Sherry small casks prior to release. The cup that stands at the top-center of the label is the bowl of hygeia, paying homage to the origin of Amaro, and its medicinal healing properties.

## **Pilla Rabarbaro, Emilia Romagna 1970's 16% 35**

Originating in the heart of Venice, the Pilla brothers owe much of their fame the creation of Select Aperitivo which they launched in 1920. Their rhubarb amaro hails from the distillery in Bologna.

## **Ramazotti, Lombardy**

In 1815, Ausano Ramazzotti owned a herbalist shop that also sold wines and spirits – and had a small laboratory on site where the original amaro recipe was conceived. Today the Amaro contains 33 herbs and botanicals including orange peel, Chinese star anise, angelica root, quinine, rose petals, and vanilla. The Liquore di San Cristoforo is an after dinner liqueur that has been discontinued.

## **San Faustino Amaro Presolana, Lombardy 1970's/80's 28% 25**

An alpine amaro created in Bergamo by the Bergamelli family, this original formula is aged in large Slovenian oak casks. It has since been acquired by the Zanin 1895 Distillery in Veneto who produces a slightly different recipe at 35% ABV.

## **San Faustino Latte di Suocera, Lombardy 1960's/70's 75% 30**

This “mother-in-law's milk” was inadvertently created in 1958 by Mr. Bergamelli who was late to his mother-in-law's (“suocera”) birthday and had forgotten to buy her a gift. On his way out of the distillery office, he grabbed a bottle of a liqueur that they had been working on and wrote “Happy Birthday Mother-in-Law” on the bottle. He claims he didn't know it was 75% alcohol, but some question the true intent of the gift. Technically speaking, Latte di Suocera is a “centerbe” which translates to 100 herbs, macerated and aged for 4 months in oak. Centerbe tends to have alcohol levels north of 70%, hence the skull on the label to alert the uninitiated. We recommend you proceed with caution just as you would with one's mother-in-law.

## **Santa Maria Novella, Tuscany**

Founded in Florence in 1221, Santa Maria Novella is one of the world's oldest pharmacies. At one point they made treatments for the bubonic plague; today, they make award-winning beauty products and perfumes with a cult following, as well as nine different rare elixirs.

Elisir di Edimburgo 35% 28

The original recipe comes from a Dominican monk who visited Florence in the 17th century from a monastery in Edinburgh. According to the archives this is one of the oldest liquors produced by Officina.



# VINTAGE AMARI

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## **Stock Fernet, Friuli 1960's 41% 40**

In 1884, Lionello Stock founded Camis & Stock on the heels of the Panic of 1873 (or The Long Depression). It wasn't until 1927 that they produced their first fernet only to be hit by the Great Depression and then seized by the Nazis in 1939. In 1948 following World War 2, the distillery became national property. The original Fernet is approximately 38% alcohol with the Italian version clocking in at 41%.

## **Zucca Rabarbaro, Lombardy 1970's 16% 55**

The original recipe dates back to 1845 when a doctor prescribed rhubarb and medicinal herbs to a woman named Tilde Zucca to aid her digestion. Her husband Ettore decided to add alcohol to the concoction (as one does with their medicine). Its popularity in Milan's cafes as an aperitif quickly rose and in the early 1900s, a descendant of Ettore established the Zucca Company to begin commercial production. The alcohol was doubled from 15% to 30% in 2016.

# VINTAGE ITALIAN SPIRITS

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## **Camel Cora Crema Goccia D'oro, Friuli 1950's 30% 35**

Founded in 1943 in Udine, Distillerie Camel now specializes in distillates and infusions for pastry chefs. Goccia d'Oro, or "Drop of Gold" is a style of citrus-based liqueur infused with herbs and spices. Best enjoyed on a rock.

## **Campari Cordial 1960's 36% 65**

Originally created in March 1888, it was only produced through 1992. Unlike its bitter older brother, Campari Cordial is a raspberry liqueur. The distillery was founded by Gaspare Campari in Milan in 1860. After his passing in 1882, Davide (one of his five sons) took over and was responsible for creating Campari Cordial, as well as the evolution of the branding and introduction of the now-famous aperitif posters.

## **Gavioli, Nocino, Emilia Romagna 1970's 40% 20**

Gavioli Guiseppe & Figli was founded in 1965, specializing in brandy and other distillates. The local nocino is a specialty of Modena; Gavioli became one of the most sought-after green walnut liquors of its time.

## **ILLVA, Amaretto di Saronno 1960's/70's 28% 18**

Amaretto di Saronno dates back to the early 1900's when Domenico Reina opened a grocery store where he sold his family liqueur, which he called Amaretto di Saronno Originale. Amaretto translates to "a little bitter". Originally it was made using the mandorla amara which is the bitter rind native to Saronno in Northwest Italy near the Swiss border. Today it is made with apricot kernels, burnt sugar, and 17 herbs and fruits. In 1947 the business was incorporated as ILLVA Saronno. ILLVA stands for Industria, Lombarda, Liquori, Vini & Affini (Industry, Lombarda, Spirits, Wines & Allied Products). It wasn't imported into the US until the 1960's, and by the 1980's was second in liqueur sales only to Kahlua. In 2001 it was rebranded as Disaronno Originale as an homage to Dominico's original concoction.

## **Nardini, Ginepro del Grappa, Veneto 1960's/70's 45%. 17**

Nardini is the oldest distillery in Italy, dating back to 1779. Today the distillery enjoys a place on the distinguished list of Historical Places in Italy. Genepro is a grappa-based liquor redistilled with wild cumin, juniper berries and other herbs. It is slightly sweet, smoothing out the grappa's sharp edges.

## **Vecchia Romagna Etichetta Nera, Emilia Romagna 1970's 40% 25**

The iconic Italian brandy with French roots dates back to the early 1700's when the Buton family produced cognac for Napoleon I. In the early 1800's Jean Buton moved to Bologna where, inspired by the local viticulture, he started his distillery in 1820. Over the following decade it became the first steam distillery in Italy specializing in "cognac" until 1939 when they changed the name to Vecchia Romagna and introduced the eponymous triangular bottle. Sadly, the distillery was destroyed in WWII four years later. Vecchia Romagna refers to the signature production methods which includes a first distillation in Charentais alembic stills, followed by a continuous distillation in a column still before being aged in both French barriques and large Slovenian casks.
