

Wines by the Bottle

White

Sonoma Cutrer Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, CA- 45

A classic Buttery Chardonnay, this wine demonstrates subtle complexities with flavors of popcorn, vanilla, toasted nuts, and hints of nougat.

Aslina Sauvignon Blanc, Stellenbosch, SA-52

Produced by the first female black wine maker in South Africa, this Sauvignon Blanc is finished with a touch of Semillion to round out the body. Notes of Lemon Zest and Tropical Fruit make for a beautifully bright wine with tons of depth and lasting silky finish.

Love Cork Screw "Good Times Good Friends" Pinot Grigio, Lakeshore, MI- 40

Crishon Lampley, from the South Loop in Chicago, dedicates herself to proving that in a male-dominated industry, women have equally as much (let's be real...more) to offer in the world of viticulture. This crisp, clean expression of Pinot Grigio rings true with green apple, bosc pear, and mango. Delightful!

Francine & Olivier Savary Chablis, Maligny, FR- 60

This subtle and delicate interpretation of Chardonnay is a true testament to the meaning of "terroir." Excellent minerality gives way to limestone, almond, and crushed seashells. Perfect for those looking for an unoaked Chardonnay.

Rosé

Domaine Tempier, Bandol, FR-60

One of Our Favorites, Tempier is widely considered to be one of the best producers of Rosé in the world. This traditional Provençal blend offers a unique combination of complexity and freshness. Flavors of peach, strawberry, and slate make this wine enormously food friendly, but equally as good to enjoy by itself on a hot summer day.

Red

Domaine de la Chanteleuserie Cabernet Franc, Bourgueil, FR- 52

For those who are able to down red wine in the Ohio humidity, this wine will bring you instant joy. A medium-plus body reveals flavors of black plum, cranberries, and leather. We recommend it slightly chilled, the way the French like it.

Castello di Volpaia Chianti Classico, Chianti, IT-60

Representing its region with verve and panache, this wine offers exactly what most people are looking for in Chianti. This vivid, ruby wine tastes of cherries and currants while holding onto the austere acidity for which Italian reds are known.

Nowhere In Particular Wandering Winery Pinot Noir, Willamette, OR- 60

Brought to you in part by a local Daytonian, Pat Sullivan, this nomadic winery travels the globe to coax the finest expressions from a plethora of varietals. This more savory Pinot delivers hints of dark cherries, mineral, and baking spices. DAYTON STRONG!

Azienda Vinicola Palladino Nebbiolo, Barolo, IT-65

We love Barolo! Underbrush, grilled herbs, steeped berries, balsamic, and a touch of scorched earth are just the start to this beautiful and deeply complex invocation of the Nebbiolo grape.

Oaked in the "Nuovo Stile," you will not be disappointed.

B. Happy "B. Leighton" Syrah, Yakima Valley, WA- 80

Like an Earl Stanley Gardner novella, this wine is dark and brooding. Wet Earth, Herbs De Provence, and Black Cherry make this Syrah firm, luscious, and unyielding. The only difference between this wine and Gardner's work? The wine actually has a joyful ending.
