

white wines



2024 Sauvignon Blanc / Via Alpina / Friuli, Italy 49

Citrus, green apple, and white peach with a crisp, mineral-driven finish. From Friuli's gravelly, alluvial soils at the foothills of the Alps, this Sauvignon Blanc is cool-fermented in stainless steel to highlight its bright acidity and alpine freshness.

2023 Gruner Veltliner / Leth / Wagram, Austria 50

Green apple, white peach, and lime zest with notes of radish and crushed white pepper, finishing crisp and mineral. Grown on loess soils in Austria's Wagram region, fermented in stainless steel to preserve purity and freshness

2023 Treixadura / Ailalá Ribeiro / Ribeiro, Galicia, Spain 66

Apricot, white flowers, sea-shell minerality, and lemon peel with crisp acidity and a clean, rounded finish. From biodynamically farmed Treixadura vines on "sábrego" (granite-sand) soils in the Avia Valley, hand-harvested and aged four months on lees with gentle bâtonnage for added texture.

2023 Albariño / Do Ferreiro / Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain 90

Lime zest, white flowers, sea-spray minerality and a clean, bright finish. From hand-harvested vines on granitic "sábrego" soils in the Salnés Valley, organically farmed, naturally fermented in stainless steel with six to nine months on lees—showing clarity, drive and coastal elegance.

2022 Turbiana / Tomassi / Lugana, Italy 47

Fresh, creamy yellow fruit mingles with smoky nuance, while holding balanced acidity. From clay-rich soils near Lake Garda, one day of skin contact and three months sur lie aging in stainless steel—textured and quietly expressive.

2021 Chenin Blanc / A.A. Badenhorst / Swartland, South Africa 96

Yellow peach, almond skin, wet stone, and beeswax with lively acidity and a textured finish. From dry-farmed bush vines on granite and schist in Swartland, this Chenin is hand-harvested, naturally fermented, and aged on lees in old foudres and concrete.

2021 Chardonnay / Domaine Rolet / Jura, France 78

Green apple, lemon peel, almond skin, and wet stone with taut acidity. From marl and limestone soils in Arbois, this cool-climate wine is fermented with native yeast and aged 10 months in mostly neutral French oak—precise, textured, and unmistakably Jura.

2022 Chardonnay / Merryvale / Napa Valley, California 75

Peach, baked apple, lemon curd, and toasted brioche with creamy texture and a long, spiced finish. From estate fruit in Carneros, this Chardonnay is barrel-fermented with native yeast and aged 12 months in 30% new French oak—rich, layered, and classically Napa in style.

2019 Chardonnay / Michel Gay et Fils / Beaune 1er Cru "Coucherias," Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France. 120

Ripe pear, golden apple, and lemon curd with notes of hazelnut, brioche, and a hint of flint, layered over a creamy yet precise texture. From old vines on limestone-rich slopes in Beaune's Premier Cru Coucherias, this Chardonnay is fermented and aged in French oak (30% new), showing the finesse and depth of a top-tier white Burgundy—structured, mineral, and beautifully balanced.

2023 Riesling Incline / J & H Selbach / Mosel, Germany 52

Crisp green apple, lime zest, and white peach with bright acidity and a clean, slate-driven finish. From steep Mosel slate slopes, fermented in stainless steel.

2021 Gewürztraminer / Zind-Humbrecht / Alsace, France 79

Lychee, rose petal, ginger, and candied orange peel with a rich texture and a long finish. From biodynamically farmed vineyards in Alsace, fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged on lees in large oak barrels—opulent, aromatic, and a benchmark expression of the varietal.

orange wines

2019 Mtsvane / Marbano / Kakheti, Georgia 49

Ripe pear, white peach, quince, and a hint of ginger with firm tannins and a dry, structured finish. Crafted from estate-grown Mtsvane grapes in Kakheti, this amber-hued wine is fermented and aged in qvevri (clay amphorae) using traditional Georgian methods—textured and expressive

2022 La Colline Rouge/ Marcel Deiss / Alsace, France 79

Wild strawberry, red cherry skin, crushed herbs, and firm yet silky tannins with a lifted, mineral-driven finish. From biodynamic vines on the limestone-rich Rotenberg slope in Bergheim, this co-planted field blend undergoes a remarkable 10-month skin maceration with natural fermentation before aging in large neutral foudres, highlighting deep texture, structure, and pure terroir expression.

sparkling wines



NV Prosecco / Carpenè Malvolti / Veneto, Italy 49

Green apple, pear, white flowers, and citrus zest with fine, lively bubbles and a crisp, refreshing finish. Founded in 1868 and considered one of Prosecco's pioneering houses, Carpenè Malvolti sources Glera from hillside vineyards in the Veneto and produces this wine using the Martinotti–Charmat method

NV Blanc de Blancs / Schramsberg / North Coast, CA 80

Green apple, lemon zest, and white flowers with fine bubbles and a crisp, mineral-driven finish. Sourced from cool-climate mountain vineyards across Napa, Sonoma, and Mendocino, this traditional-method Blanc de Blancs is hand-harvested, whole-cluster pressed, and aged on lees

2018 Extra Brut (Pinot Noir, Chardonnay) / Moorilla / Tamar Valley, Tasmania 87

Red-apple skin, lemon peel, and light brioche with fine bubbles and a precise, mineral-driven finish. Founded in 1958 and now centered around its Tamar Valley St. Matthias vineyard, Moorilla farms basalt-rich, cool-climate slopes; the fruit is hand-harvested, whole-cluster pressed, wild-yeast fermented, and aged extensively on lees before disgorgement for added tension and depth.

NV Champagne / Veuve Clicquot / Champagne, France 120

Green apple, pear, lemon peel, and brioche with fine bubbles and a crisp, balanced finish. A Pinot Noir–led blend sourced across Champagne's chalk and limestone soils, fermented in stainless steel and aged on lees in bottle to deliver its signature structure and subtle toasty complexity.

NV Champagne Pere & Fils / Lanson / Champagne, France 90

Green apple, citrus peel, white flowers, and light toasted notes with firm acidity and a clean, mineral finish. A Pinot Noir–driven cuvée sourced from chalk-rich vineyards across Champagne, vinified without malolactic fermentation and aged extensively on lees before disgorgement

NV Brut Rose / Filipa Pato / Beiras, Portugal 56

Wild strawberry, raspberry, and rose petal with hints of brioche and sea breeze. From biodynamically farmed Baga grapes grown on limestone soils in Portugal's Beiras region, spends extended time on the lees for texture and complexity

2023 Sparkling Albarino / Sparkling Albarino / Sonoma, California 65

A bright, sparkling Albariño with notes of citrus blossom, kumquat, and green apple. Made using the traditional method with native yeast, it offers a bit more body and a touch of funkiness compared to a classic Brut.

NV Pet Nat / Sauvage Spectrum / Grand Valley, Colorado 49

Hazy golden Pet-Nat with soft bubbles and notes of citrus, stewed quince, and pineapple. Naturally fermented and bottled unfiltered with no dosage or disgorgement. More body and funk than your typical bubbles, with zippy acidity and a wild streak.

NV Lambrusco / Medici Ermete / Emilia-Romagna, Italy 39

Black cherry, wild berry, and violet with a lively sparkle and a dry, lifted finish. From family-run vineyards in Emilia-Romagna, this Lambrusco is made using a short maceration for color and aromatics, then undergoes secondary fermentation in tank

2019 Moscato Bianco (375mL) / Michele Chiarlo / Moscato d'Asti, Piedmont, Italy 27

Peach, apricot, and orange blossom with delicate bubbles and a fresh, sweet finish. From hillside vineyards in Piedmont, gently pressed and fermented at low temperatures to preserve its natural effervescence. Served in ½ bottle only

rose wines

2023 Grenache, Syrah, Rolle / Château d'Estoublon / Provence, France 45

Wild strawberry, white peach, and citrus zest with a crisp, dry, and lightly saline finish. From limestone and clay soils in Les Baux-de-Provence, this Grenache-Syrah-Rolle blend is hand-harvested, gently pressed, and fermented at cool temperatures

2023 Sangiovese / La Spinetta / Tuscany, Italy 49

Wild strawberry, raspberry, and rose petal with crisp acidity and a clean, mineral-edged finish. From organically farmed Sangiovese grown on sandy and limestone soils in Tuscany's Casanova vineyards, the wine is gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel to preserve purity, freshness, and its precise, elegant style.

red wines



- 2023 Lagrein / Elena Walch / Alto Adige DOC. Italy 46**
- Dark berries, black plum, and violet with lively acidity and firm tannins. From limestone and porphyry soils in Alto Adige, this Lagrein undergoes a 10-day maceration, malolactic fermentation, and maturation in large French and Slavonian oak casks.
- 2022 Gamay / Domaine de Fa / Beaujolais. France 75**
- Raspberry, red cherry, herbs, and a touch of peppery spice with a silky, lifted finish. From high-altitude granite and stony soils near Saint-Amour, naturally fermented with whole clusters and aged in a mix of cement and large oak barrels—fresh, structured, and quietly complex.
- 2021 Pinot Noir / Emeritus / Russian River Valley. CA 88**
- Ripe raspberry, black cherry, and cola layered with rose petal, baking spice. From the cool, fog-laced Hallberg Ranch in the Russian River Valley, this sustainably farmed Pinot Noir is aged in French oak (40% new).
- 2023 Pinot Noir/ Chehalem / Willamette Valley. Oregon 54**
- Bright red cherry, raspberry and spiced blackberry, rose petal and a touch of earth, finishing with lively acidity. Fermented with indigenous yeasts and matured ten months in neutral French oak
- 2022 Pinot Noir/ La Pèpée / Jura. France 150**
- Red cherry, wild strawberry, crunchy cranberry, and subtle earthy spice with a lifted, silky finish. Grown on limestone soils in the Jura, comes from low-yielding vines, hand-harvested fruit, natural fermentation, and aging in neutral barrels.
- 2021 Pinot Noir/ Domaine Jean Fery & Fils / Cote de Nuits-Villages Clos de Magny. France 195**
- Red cherry, redcurrant, and floral notes with gentle earth and a clean, structured finish. From the monopole Clos de Magny in the Côte de Nuits-Villages, this Pinot Noir grows on limestone and marl, is hand-picked, naturally fermented
- 2023 Langhe Rosso/ G.D. Vajra / Piedmonte. Italy 53**
- Red cherry, wild raspberry, and subtle floral spice with a bright, vibrant finish. From estate vineyards across the Langhe in Piedmont, this blend—led by Nebbiolo with Dolcetto, Barbera, and small amounts of Freisa, Albarossa, and Pinot Nero—is fermented in stainless steel and aged in a mix of steel and neutral oak.
- 2023 Barbera D'Asti/ Bava / Piedmonte. Italy 60**
- Bright red cherry, plum skin, and violet with subtle spice and a juicy, medium-bodied finish. Sourced from estate vineyards in the rolling hills of Asti on calcareous marl soils, fermented in stainless steel and aged briefly in large Slavonian oak casks.
- 2022 Barbera D'Alba / Fratelli Cigliuti / Neive. Italy 89**
- Ripe black cherry, plum, and violet with savory notes of spice and a long, textured finish. From the Serraboella cru in Neive, where Barbera thrives on calcareous clay soils, this wine is aged in large oak casks to balance richness and freshness, showcasing the depth of Barbera d'Alba.
- 2023 Nero D'Avola / Cusumano / Sicily. Italy 38**
- Ripe blackberry, plum, and dark cherry with hints of spice and a supple, velvety finish. Grown in Sicily's inland hills on limestone-rich soils, this Nero d'Avola is fermented in stainless steel
- 2022 Domaine Vico/ Niellucciu. Sciaccarellu/Corsica. France 92**
- Bright red cherry, rasperry, and wild herbs with hints of pepper and a lifted, silky finish. From the granite and schist soils of Corsica's central highlands, this blend is fermented in stainless steel and aged in large neutral casks, capturing the island's savory, aromatic character.
- 2023 Grenache. Syrah. Carignan / Domaine De La Bastide / Cotes du Rhone. France 50**
- Ripe fig, black cherry, dried thyme, and cracked pepper with a plush mid-palate and gently rustic tannins. Fermented in stainless steel and aged in concrete—earthy, open-knit, and deeply rooted in regional character.
- 2018 Saperavi / Villa Mosavali / Kakheti. Georgia 59**
- Blackberry, sour cherry, plum, and clove with firm tannins and a dark, earthy finish. From sun-exposed vineyards in Kakheti on alluvial and loamy soils, this Saperavi is aged in French oak for structure while retaining the deep color and natural intensity typical of the variety.
- 2021 Langhe Nebbiolo / Prunotto / Piedmonte. Italy 69**
- Raspberry, rose petal, and licorice with fine-grained tannins and a graceful, lingering finish. Sourced from sandy, gravel-rich soils in the Roero hills, aged for 16 months—elegant, aromatic, and a refined introduction to Piedmont's noble grape.
- 2024 Dolcetto D'Alba / G.D. Vajra / Piedmonte. Italy 60**
- Black cherry, plum, violet, and a touch of almond with bright acidity and fine tannins. From Dolcetto vines at 350–400 m in the Langhe, rooted in clay-limestone and marl soils, this fruit is hand-harvested, fermented and aged entirely in stainless steel.
- 2022 Super Tuscan / Tenuta Sette Ponti / Tuscany. Italy 83**
- Black cherry, blackberry, lavender, and spice with a dense, structured finish. Sourced from hillside vineyards in Tuscany with clay and galestro soils, primarily Sangiovese—aged 12 months in French oak, delivering depth, balance, and classic Tuscan character.

2020 Aglianico / Tenuta Bocca di Lupo/ 149

Castel del Monte DOC. Italy

Blackberry, plum, and violet with hints of leather, tobacco, and crushed herbs. From limestone and clay soils at high elevation in Castel del Monte, this 100% Aglianico is organically farmed and aged in French oak - powerful, structured, and elegantly southern Italian in character.

2021 Cabernet Franc Domaine Amirault / Saint- 95 Nicolas-de-Bourgueil. Loire Valley. France

Blackberry, blackcurrant, and black pepper with silky tannins and a long, balanced finish. From organically and biodynamically farmed vineyards on gravel and sand in Saint-Nicolas-de-Bourgueil, fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged without filtration

2022 Cabernet Franc / Domaine de Bois Mozé / 64 Anjou. Loire Valley. France

Black raspberry, graphite dust, green peppercorn, and a hint of earthy root with a firm, structured finish. From clay-rich granite slopes in Anjou, this terroir-driven Cabernet Franc is hand-harvested, naturally fermented, and aged in large old barrels.

2022 Carignan / Mas La Mola / Priorat Catalunya. Spain 66

Plum, black cherry, smoke, dried thyme, and crushed rock with firm tannins and a bold, mineral-driven finish. From steep, terraced vineyards in Priorat rooted in llicorella slate at high elevation, aged 12 months in French oak, capturing the region's depth and intensity.

2022 GSM / Frequency Wines / Santa Barbara County. CA 75

Red cherry, raspberry, dried rose, and warm spice with a lifted, silky texture and gentle herbal notes. Sourced from sustainably farmed vineyards across Santa Barbara County on sandy loam and shale soils, this Grenache-led blend is fermented with native yeasts and aged in neutral barrels

2022 Malbec / Finca Decero / Agrelo. Mendoza. Argentina 60

Blackberry, plum, and violets with subtle cocoa and fine, polished tannins. From high-elevation alluvial soils in Agrelo (around 1,050–1,100 m), this single-vineyard Malbec is hand-harvested, fermented in stainless steel, and aged in French oak

2023 Syrah / Jean Baptiste Souillard 98 / Rhone. France

Crushed black cherry, black olive tapenade, graphite and a fine peppery edge with a sleek, mineral-tinted finish. Sourced from elevated granite-rich parcels in the Northern Rhône, this Syrah is bottled after wild-yeast fermentation, partial whole-cluster inclusion, and ageing in older oak

2021 Continental Divide Winery / Winter is Coming / 119 Grand Valley. Colorado

Fig, cracked pepper, and hints of olive and baking spice with firm tannins and a bold, polished finish. 59% Syrah and 41% Petit Verdot grown in Grand Valley AVA, fermented with whole clusters and aged in 40% new oak.

2021 Barolo Albe / GD. Vajra / Piedmonte. Italy 98

Red cherry, dried rose petal, tangy cranberry and a hint of forest floor with fine-grained tannins and a clean, lifted finish. From high-elevation vineyards (380-480 m) in Barolo with exposures from SSE to SW, this 100% Nebbiolo is grown on limestone-marl soils, fermented with native yeasts, and aged in large neutral casks.

2020 Right Bank Bordeaux / Château Pipeau / 108 Saint-Émilion Grand Cru

Red cherry, plum, blackberry, and a touch of cocoa with supple tannins and a smooth, lingering finish. From clay-limestone and gravel parcels in Saint-Émilion Grand Cru on Bordeaux's Right Bank, this Merlot-led blend with Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon is fermented in stainless steel and aged in French oak.

2022 Left Bank Bordeaux / Château Giscours / 280 Margaux. France

Blackcurrant, plum, violet and graphite with fine, refined tannins and a long, elegant finish. From the gravel-rich croupes of Margaux, this Cabernet Sauvignon-driven blend (64% Cab Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot, 3% Cab Franc) is fermented in stainless steel and concrete, aged ~12-15 months in French oak (=50% new). #1 in Wine Spectator's "Top 100" list for 2025

2021 Cabernet Sauvignon / Honig / Napa Valley. CA 129

Black raspberry, coconut, dark spice, and espresso with dense texture and a deep, velvety finish. Sourced from estate vineyards in Rutherford on gravelly alluvial soils, this Cabernet Sauvignon is aged 18 months in a mix of American oak and new French oak.

2021 Cabernet Sauvignon 'Rattlesnake' / 470 Barnett Vineyards / Moon Mountain District Napa Valley. CA

Blackcurrant, dark plum, espresso grounds, and graphite with firm tannins and a lingering, structured finish. Grown on steep, rocky slopes in the Spring Mountain District of Napa Valley, this Cabernet Sauvignon is hand-harvested, wild-yeast fermented, and aged in French oak from multiple cooperages.
