

# Where to score game day dining deals in Palm Beach County

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With the college football and NFL seasons just starting, the WNBA play-offs fast approaching and the 2026 NBA season tipoff just around the corner, it's time to make sure that culinary/dining destination playbook is in order.

Whether your game day menu leans traditional with beers, burgers and wings or ventures toward the more avant-garde with Thai lettuce wraps, gazpacho shooters and sparkling water, food and drink are central to the big-game experience.

Yes, let your palate guide you, but also realize that there are plenty of game-day deals to be found throughout Palm Beach County.

Here are several options to help you merge the thrill of competition with the satisfaction of seriously delicious grinds.

## Topside at the Beacon, Jupiter

Jupiter's only rooftop bar has upped its game-day experience with six new televisions along with drink specials and football-inspired bites. A few of these include the Kickoff Chicken Dip, Buffalo chicken dip with chips, for \$12; their Red Zone Wings, featuring eight bone-in wings in Buffalo, barbecue, or garlic Parmesan sauce, for \$16; the Blitz Burger, featuring a single smash patty, aged cheddar, and caramelized onion aioli, with fries, for \$12; and the Fumble Fish Sandwich, prepared either grilled, blackened, or fried, with a chili crisp remoulade, lettuce, tomato, and onion, for \$20. They will also offer Touchdown buckets featuring a choice of six bottles, cans or seltzers for \$30 and a rotating signature cocktail, the Sideline Punch, for \$12.
