

*both elegant and concentrated but light on its feet. rich tobacco and plum notes. an incredibly long finish. the colle vota vineyard allows for generous hangtime so these grapes produce a truly unique montepulciano*

You can taste Cristiana's intense passion for Abruzzo in these wines, particularly in the single vineyard bottlings which are all richly aromatic and elegant.
