

21 Fall-Inspired Espresso Martinis To Keep An Eye Out For

There's no doubt that espresso martinis continue to be one of the trendiest cocktails around these days. Naturally as the seasons change, bartenders around the country are creating versions of the caffeinated cocktail filled with flavors of fall — from the obvious pumpkin and cinnamon to warm

Chai Jennings Java Martini at Lumin Skybar in Columbus, Ohio

On the newly debuted fall cocktail menu at Lumin Skybar is a Chai Jennings Java Martini made with chainfused Watershed Vodka (locally distilled in Ohio), coffee liquor, vanilla, and java concentrate from local Jennings Coffee Roasters.

Beso De Espresso from Beaker & Gray in Miami, Florida

This version combines cold brew with orange cordial and candied pistachios making for an aromatic and nutty drink that's perfect for Fall sipping. "The Beso de Espresso is the ideal pickme-up with two hits of espresso—one from the housemade cold brew espresso and one from the punchy Mr. Black Cold Brew Espresso Liqueur. The autumnal essence comes from the combination of orange citrus, pistachio, and pandan. Finally, Ketel One vodka ties everything together to warm (or cool down) the soul in these chilly (or balmy) Fall months," says co-owner Ben Potts.

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
