# MEAT MARKET

If there were any cardinal rules in our “Meat and Potato” business, the phrase “Steak goes best with Cabernet” would probably be one of them. This may have been true when our founder, Alan Stillman opened Smith & Wollensky in the 1970’s, when his cellar might be limited by what was available in the market back then. However, much has happened in the world of wine since then. So this begs the question:

Is this Steak = Cabernet rule *still* the golden rule?

In this section we call the Meat Market, our team has hand-picked a short but diverse list of wines that are not made from Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. From varieties indigenous to Italy to classic French varieties grown here in the USA these powerful red wines will work well with any of our cuts of steak.

**Colterris 2016 Malbec *Western Slope, Colorado* 65**  
*Malbec was made famous in Argentina where it is grown in high altitude desert vineyards in the foothills of the Andes Mountains. This Malbec is grown in a similar climate at almost a mile high at 4,785 ft. on Colorado’s Western Slope. The wine is fruit forward with notes of ripe berry fruit, vanilla, and peppery spice.*

**Scacciadiavoli 2012 Montefalco di Sagrantino DCG *Umbria* 86**  
*Founded in 1884 by Prince Ugo Boncompagni-Ludovisi of Rome. The name Scacciadiavoli means “to banish the devil”, it refers to an 18<sup>th</sup> century incident when a young woman was possessed by the devil and was made to drink the local red wine by an exorcist in order to banish the demon. Sagrantino is big and tannic, with flavors of red berries, plums, baking spices, and leather.*

**Pride 2015 Merlot *Napa / Sonoma* 100**  
*Formerly known as Summit Ranch, Pride Mountain Vineyards is a 235 acre estate that sits at the very top of Spring Mountain on the border of Napa and Sonoma at an elevation of 2,100 feet. Being on the mountain top gives the vines desirable Southern exposure. This Mountain Merlot is full bodied with ripe fruit aromas of blackberry, along with chocolate, spice and graphite.*

**Orin Swift ‘8 Years in the Desert’ 2017 Zinfandel Blend *California* 114**  
*Winemaker Dave Phinney got his start in the wine business by creating a Zinfandel based red blend called The Prisoner. After selling the brand, he was banned from making wine with Zinfandel for 8 years due to a non-competitor agreement. This is Phinney’s return to Zinfandel winemaking. This bold wine has notes of blackberry, plum, espresso, and a hint of smokiness.*

**Bodega Numanthia ‘Numanthia’ 2016 Toro DO *Castilla y Leon, Spain* 124**  
*Named for the Numancia warriors of Spain who sacrificed their lives rather than surrender to Romans. Made from the Tinto de Toro grape in an extremely hot region of Spain, this wine is powerful and intense. The wine has fruit flavors of raspberry, blackberry, and cherry with aromas of mint, clove, and tobacco.*

**Giovanni Montisci ‘Barrosu’ 2016 Cannonau di Sardegna DOC *Sardinia* 155**  
*Giovanni Montisci’s Cannonau is meticulously and organically farmed from 80 year old vines at 650 meters of elevation. Previously selling his grapes in bulk, Giovanni decided to make his own wine for the first time in 2004 and since then he has earned a cult-like following for his powerful and distinctive wines. The wine is rich and complex with notes of ripe red fruit and Mediterranean herbs.*

**Secondo Marco 2012 Amarone della Valpolicella DCG *Veneto* 182**  
*Amarone is made from Corvina, Rondinella and Molinari grapes that are dried after being harvested. After fermentation, the wine is aged in large oak barrels for at least 6 years! This creates a rich, full-bodied wine with elegant texture and flavors of cooked fruit and vanilla bean. The Speri family is one of the legendary winemaking families of Valpolicella and helped create the very first Amarone wines.*

**Cayuse ‘Cailloux’ 2016 Syrah *Walla Walla, Washington* 250**  
**Cayuse ‘Bionic Frog’ 2016 Syrah *Walla Walla, Washington* 305**  
*Cayuse is a domaine located in the Walla Walla Valley. Over the past 20 years, French Winemaker Christophe Baron, has made it his mission to craft food-friendly wines of incredible depth, individuality and character from fruit grown biodynamic farming methods. The wines are critically-lauded each year.*

**Bruno Giacosa ‘Santo Stefano di Nieve’ 2011 Barbaresco *Piedmont* 350**  
*Bruno Giacosa crafts the most prestigious single-vineyard Barbarescos in Piedmont. And this wine is the most collectible Barbaresco in the world. The tiny 5 acre Santo Stefano vineyard was planted in 1967 and the old vines produce a concentrated wine that is then aged in French Oak barrels for two years. This wine is incredibly powerful with notes of truffle, dried cherry, tobacco, and black licorice.*

**Colgin IX Estate 2012 Syrah *Napa* 450**  
*Colgin is sold only to select restaurants and individual clients who are fortunate enough to be on their mailing list. Robert Parker says the Colgin IX Estate is “as close to a viticultural nirvana as I’ve ever seen.” Grapes are grown on southeast facing slopes on the estate which is perched high atop Pritchard Hill overlooking Lake Hennessey in the St. Helena area of Napa. This wine is voluptuous and savory with notes of acacia, blackberry, pepper, and coffee.*
