WINE REGIONS

- Piedmont:** Piemonte (pee-ay-MON-tay). Cupped by the Alps in the north with the Apennines to the south. These two main AVAs of Piedmont bring us distinctively different wines. Classic white varietals, such as Moscato, Cortese, and Arneis from the north, in the foothills of the Alps, around Gattinara bring us much cooler climates producing much lighter tasting, higher acid wines. To the south in the Apennines the ice cold Alps and the warm Mediterranean bring us a diurnal temperature variation, bringing us the bolder reds such as Barolo, Barbaresco, and Barbera.
- Lombardy:** (luhm-baar-dee) located in north-central Italy, is a wine region that is primarily known for its sparkling wines from Franciacorta and Oltrepo-Pavese. In addition, the region produces red wines from Nebbiolo grapes in the Valtellina region and rosé wines in areas around Lake Garda.
- Trentino-Alto Adige:** (tren-tee-now, al-tow, aa-dee-jay) Northeast just below Austria, Alto Adige lies in a Y shaped glacial valley where it is known for their cooler climates and crisp whites. The valley was one of the few gateways into Italy from Europe prior to planes. Now the most predominant Pinot Grigio producer in all of Italy. Just South of Alto Adige lies Trentino, an area well known for their Sparkling wines.
- Friuli Venezia Giulia:** (free-oo-lee, vuh-net-see-uh, joo-lee-uh), Friuli-Venezia Giulia lies in the top-right corner of Italy, between Austria, Slovenia, the Adriatic Sea, and Veneto (Venice!). Although the region is relatively small compared to the rest of Italy, it ranks among the best for producers of white wines.
- Veneto:** (vuh-neh-tow) is located in the northeast of Italy. It stretches from the Dolomites to the Adriatic Sea and comprises a wide low mountain range and a lowland of lakes, rivers, canals, and the Po Delta. This expansive region provides many varietals ranging from unique white wines such as Prosecco, Garganega, Chardonnay, and Pinot Grigio, to the distinct red varieties Corvina, Raboso, Cabernet, and Merlot.
- Tuscany:** Tuscany (tuh-skuh-nee) stretches picturesquely along the Ligurian coast in Italy and is one of the most prestigious wine-growing regions in the world. Optimal geological and climatic conditions, of Tuscany produce high-quality wines with a unique touch. On the barren limestone soils of Tuscany, the vines are spoiled with plenty of sun and rain producing very popular wines such as Brunello di Montalcino, Chianti and Super Tuscans thrive here.

WINE REGIONS

- Emilia-Romagna:** (uh-mee-lee-uh, row-maa-nyuh) located in North Central Italy neighboring the Adriatic sea is the Land of Lambrusco, a sweet and sparkling red wine, the most famous grape variety of the region.
- Le Marche:** (leh-mar-keh) is located in the eastern part of Italy between the Adriatic sea and Apennine mountains and is characterized by hilly, mountainous landscape and sandy beaches. However, if you move further inland you will discover the beauty of its countryside, dotted by medieval villages, olive trees, and vineyards spreading on the hills. Marche is popular for its white wines from Trebbiano and Verdicchio grape varieties.
- Abruzzo:** (uh-brut-sow) located in Central Italy in the Adriatic Sea with much of the wine making practices and traditions dating back to ancient Rome, historically making them the largest producers of Montepulciano and Trebbiano wines.
- Campania:** (kuhm-paa-nyuh) located in the south of Italy is world-famous for its many attractions: the Amalfi Coast, Sorrento, Positano, Ravello, Ischia, Capri, Naples, Vesuvius, as well as the two archaeological sites of Pompeii, Herculaneum, and the Greek temples at Paestum. Due to the diversity of Campanian terroirs from the hills on the coast to the volcanic soil of Vesuvius and the Mediterranean Campania Italy climate, there are many interesting wines to be discovered. The most demanding red wines are certainly Taurasi and Aglianico del Taburno made from the Aglianico grape variety.
- Puglia:** (poo-lee-uh) located in the south, comprising the heel of the boot. Puglian wine is the product of a diverse landscape. The warm climate of Puglia, combined with the fertile soil, is surrounded by water on three sides. This allows cool breezes off the Mediterranean to moderate vineyard temperatures. The most popular and widely available wines from Puglia are Salice Salentino, Negroamaro, Primitivo, and Bombino Nero.
- Sardinia:** (sar-di-nee-uhn) All Hail Vermentino! This Mediterranean island of sandy beaches and granite soils give birth each year to Vermentino di Gallura, a wonderful transparent-to-pale straw-colored white wine that's typically oak-free with bright, refreshing acidity, and hints of green apple, citrus fruit, and ripe pear. Vermentino di Gallura is the only DOCG wine of Sardinia.
- Sicily:** (si-suh-lee) The largest island in the Mediterranean and according to legend, Dionysus brought joy and wine to Sicily. But the legend aside, it is a fact that wine has been produced for thousands of years on Sicily. There is evidence that Mycenaean traders were cultivating grapes in the Aeolian Islands as early as 1,500 BC. With the large amount of wine produced in Sicily it is most known for it's Nero D'Avola, and Frappato varietals. It is also the home of Marsalla wine. A fortified cooking wine used to create nutty rich carmelized sauces.

SPARKLING

- Poggio Costa Brut Prosecco DOC N/V, Friuli-Venezia Giulia** 14.50 / 40
Dry, fresh, and crisp, with high acidity and vibrant minerality, offering subtle green apple and melon fruit notes.
- Poggio Costa Rosé Prosecco DOC N/V, Friuli-Venezia Giulia** 14.50 / 40
Bright, fruity notes of fresh peach flower, apricot, and pomegranate, with hints of honey and marzipan.
- Broletto Lambrusco DOC 2024, Emilia-Romagna** 14.50 / 40
Intense ruby-red color with black-purple notes. Scents of violet and berry fruits. Enjoy with typical dishes of Emilia-Romagna like pasta dishes, meats, cold cuts, and cheese. Also pairs well with cream and fruit desserts.
- Coppo Moncalvina Moscato DOCG 2024, Piedmont** 16 / 45
A light, sweet white wine with refreshing peach, apricot and honey flavors, offering a crisp and bubbly finish. Pairs well with mild cheeses and spice.

CHAMPAGNE

- Gaston Chiquet, Brut Tradition, N/V Champagne, FR** 80
A vivacious Champagne. Well-cut acidity, refined mousse, and notes of ripe black cherry and blackberry paste, Meyer lemon peel, biscuit, and white blossoms. The finish is lingering and mineral-driven. 40% Pinot Meunier, 35% Chardonnay, and 25% Pinot Noir.
- Gaston Chiquet, Rosé Premier Cru, N/V Champagne, FR** 87
A well-cut rosé, Champagne, offering a textured, raw silk-like mousse, with rich hints of almond biscotti and smoke to the core of wild cherry and strawberry fruit, anise and pickled ginger. 40% Pinot Noir, 30% Pinot Meunier and 30% Chardonnay.
- Billecart-Salmon, Brut Réserve, N/V Champagne, FR** 80
Clean and bright natural fruit. Floral aromatics of white stone fruits and subtle biscuity aromas. Enticing flavors of apple, crisp pear, citrus with roasted notes. A long, persistent finish marked by freshness and minerality. 43% Meunier, 29% Chardonnay, and 28% Pinot Noir.
- Philippe Fontaine, Brut Millésime, 2016 Champagne, FR** 75
A bright yellow hue with subtle reflections of copper, this elegant and fine Champagne offers aromas of lychee and peach. On the palate, this wine is lively and bright with a soft texture of almond paste, brioche, and subtle notes of blueberries. 100% Pinot Noir
- Domaine Egly-Ouriet, Extra Brut 'Les Premices', N/V Champagne, FR** 220
Pale lemon. Aromas of white flowers and marzipan, white peaches, and light herbs. Bright and precise, with peppery notes and citrus zest. Savory, with a mineral finish; long. Pairs well with charcuterie or smoked meats/fish. Equal parts Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Pinot Meunier.
- Domaine Egly-Ouriet, Grand Cru Extra Brut, N/V Champagne, FR** 350
Aromas of fresh pears, light pepper, and red fruit. Flavors of mixed red fruits, lemon zest, and mixed peppers. Pairs well with aged cheese, and white meats. 70% Pinot Noir and 30% Chardonnay

WHITE/ROSÉ

Château la Mascaronne Folly Rosé 2024, Côtes de Provence, FR

A honeyed nectarine and white flower aromas pop off the rim of the glass, dig deeper to find a tangerine citrus note. The palate is all texture and minerality-driven in this full-bodied Rosé.

Montefresco Pinot Grigio 2024, Veneto

Intense straw color and an ample, lasting fruity bouquet. The palate is dry, soft, and well balanced.

Livon Pinot Grigio Classico Collio DOC 2024, Friuli-Venezia Giulia

16 / 45

Fragrant bouquet of tropical fruits with citrus and vanilla notes. Layers of white peach fruit and lime notes. Great structure-firm acidity that finishes with almond tones. Great as an aperitif, with a variety of appetizers, seafood, poultry, and risotto.

An agile wine, with pleasant Mediterranean scents, fresh and delicate white-fleshed fruit, and a persistent finish. Ideal with aperitifs, vegetables, fried fish and fish carpaccio.

Erste-Neue Sauvignon DOC 2023, Trentino-Alto Adige

A crisp and vibrant white wine offering a combination of herbaceous, citrus, and tropical fruit notes. It is characterized by its refreshing acidity and dry finish.

Bramito Della Sala Chardonnay IGT 2024, Umbria

Bright, fresh profile with notes of Williams pear, hawthorn, and citrus (lime/lemon), balanced by hints of toasted hazelnut, vanilla, fresh butter, and biscuit/pastry cream

Refreshing, light-bodied, clean, and crisp. Bursting with zesty citrus and tropical fruit aromas of fresh grapefruit and kiwi with hints of lemongrass. Pairs well with summer salads, gazpacho, calamari, and lemon herb chicken.

Weiser-Künstler Riesling Feinherb 2024, Mosel, Germany

A bright, aromatic white wine with flavors of green apple, lime and a hint of minerality. Balanced by a crisp, slightly off-dry finish. Pairs with seafood, light chicken dishes, soft cheeses and spice.

Domaine Thomas et Fils ‘Le Perrier’ Sancerre 2023, Loire, FR

Lush and bright with ripe fruits of citrus, grapefruit, crisp green apple, and wildflowers. Classic minerality and a refined herbal character. Perfect with white fish and fresh summer vegetables.

WHITE BURGUNDY

Barraud Pouilly Fuisse 1er Cru 'En France' Chardonnay 2022, Burgundy, FR 80

An organic world-class white Burgundy from the Mâconnais. Aromas of yellow stone fruit, citrus, crushed stones. Long and plush, with good mid-palate tension. Pairs well with rich white fish, roasted chicken with herbs, and goat cheese.

Domaine Bouard-Bonnefoy Chasagne Montrachet Blanc Chardonnay 2023, Burgundy, FR 150

A naturally made, profoundly flavorful white Burgundy. Aromas of green apple, stone fruits, crisp pear. Tangy and textured, expressive mineral notes. Bright finish. Pairs well with roasted chicken with herbs and fresh shellfish with lemon.

Domaine Mazilly Père & Fils Meursault Chardonnay 2021, Burgundy, FR 115

Wonderfully rich golden in color with an almost oily quality. A rich and mineral Chardonnay with balanced flavors and a refined elegance. The taste is buttery with notes of honey, lime and a little salinity.

Domaine de la Cras Coteaux de Dijon, Chardonnay 2022, Burgundy, FR 85

On the nose, it offers a bouquet of green and yellow fruit, with notes of apple, pear, and lemon peel. The palate is clean, fresh, and energetic, with ripe fruit flavors mirroring the aromas. The wine has good weight and a bright, medium-plus acidity that adds vibrancy and length.

Henri Boillot Meursault Chardonnay 2022, Burgundy, FR 116

A Bright yellow with hints of green. Pure, slightly reductive aromas of yellow fruit, apricot, and mirabelle plum. Rich, smooth, and precise minerality with excellent length and salty finish.

Domaine Billaud-Simon Tête d'Or Chardonnay 2019, Chablis, FR 125

An opulent, balanced Chardonnay with a pale yellow-green or white gold color. Its nose offers notes of citrus (lemon, grapefruit), white flowers, and fresh apple, complemented by a distinct minerality. Supple ripe fruit flavors that harmonize with the mineral notes.

Domaine Billaud-Simon Tête d'Or Chardonnay 2020, Chablis, FR 125

Classic in style, marked by freshness and purity, delivering beautifully balanced wines with both ripeness and precision. Crisp apple and pear balanced by a clean mineral backbone, generous yet refined in style.

Domaine Billaud-Simon Montée De Tonnerre Premier Cru Chardonnay 2021, Chablis, FR 135

A cooler, more challenging season that yielded elegant, mineral-driven wines with bright acidity and finesse. Vibrant stone fruit and citrus with hints of spice and honey, finishing long and chalky.

Domaine Billaud-Simon Mont De Milieu Premier Cru Chardonnay 2022, Chablis, FR 120

A sunny vintage offering ripe fruit and roundness, yet still balanced by the hallmark Chablis freshness, approachable early but with good potential to develop. Orchard fruit including golden apple, white peach, and melon. Oyster-shell minerality carried by laser-like freshness and elegant tension.

RED BORDEAUX

Château Beau Séjour Bécot Grand Cru 2021, St. Émilion, FR 120

A refined red wine with intense blackberry and plum flavors, complemented by hints of spice and minerality, offering silky tannins and a long, elegant finish.

Grand-Puy Ducasse Grand Cru Classé 2021, Pauillac, FR 85

A sophisticated red wine with ripe blackcurrant and cassis notes, accented by subtle cedar and spices, featuring smooth tannins and a lingering finish.

Château Lanessan Grand Vin 2016, Haut-Médoc, FR 65

A robust red wine with rich flavors of black cherry and blackberry, layered with hints of leather and vanilla, offering firm tannins and a warm finish.

Château Calon Ségur Grand Cru 2020, Saint-Estéphe, FR 225

A complex red wine with deep blackberry and cassis flavors, accented by floral notes and a touch of graphite, featuring refined tannins. Pairs well with grilled steak, roasted beef, lamb, and duck.

Château Haut Nouchet 2019, Pessac-Léognan, FR 60

A classic Bordeaux blend, offering red and black fruit (plum, cassis, cherry, blackberry) with earthy, spicy notes (tobacco, cedar, graphite, cocoa) and distinctive minerality, featuring ripe tannins and integrated oak for a balanced, medium-bodied, and savory profile.

Château Branaire-Ducru, Grand Cru 2021, Saint-Julien, FR 99

A reveals a captivating nose of dark plum, blackberry and a whisper of violet. On the palate, it unfolds with a velvety texture, showcasing ripe fruit and fine tannins.

Château Lafite Rothschild Anseillon 2019, Pauillac, FR 200

Unveils a captivating nose of dark cherry, blackberry, and a touch of baking spice. On the palate, it reveals a lush profile with purple fig, cassis with hints of dark chocolate and smoke. Supported by silky tannins, leading to a lengthy, elegant finish.
