We would like to share this message to all of our partners as an advisory on the measures **A Fish Called Avalon (AFCA)** is taking to ensure our guests the utmost safety during the outbreak of novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

What is AFCA doing in our common areas?

As part of our plan, we have enacted several protocols, including an Enhanced Cleaning Protocol (ECP), which entails:

Required **hourly cleaning and disinfecting of all areas** of the building, using industrial grade germicidal products. This includes:

- Bathrooms
- Doorknob, door frames and other frequently touched areas
- Light switches, elevator buttons, and other hand-operated functions

Required sanitation on **30 minute intervals** during AFCA's hours of operation.

- Includes countertops, door knobs, computer screens, keyboards, etc.
- Our menus and chairs are also to be sanitized every 30 minutes.

Other Notable Efforts

- Sanitizer stations have been installed in several locations, most notably around the Restaurant and Lobby.
- Our service team will also have hand sanitizers available upon request.
- We are proactively working to avoid the handling of cash, and are encouraging our guests to use forms of credit instead.
- Our staff will continue their standard hand washing procedures, in tandem with regular hand sanitation when on the floor.

We wish everyone a safe journey through this health pandemic. With simple protocols like these, we will keep SoBe a safe place for ourselves and our valued guests.
