In New York City, **Danny Emerman** and **Alessandro Prospero** welcomed **Jamie Kenyon** as executive chef and partner at **Bottino**. **Harold Dieterle** marked his restaurant return with Mediterranean-inspired **Ten Hope** in Williamsburg; **Jim Handworker** serves as chef de cuisine, with **Aaron Kerr-Zengo** manning the cocktails. **Būmu** is a new izakaya in the West Village, sporting shareable plates by **Joaquin Baca (Momofuku Noodle Bar, Teo)**. Upscale coastal Italian cuisine is the bill of fare at **John DeLucie's** new Midtown restaurant, **Lumaca**. **Marble Dessert Bar** sweetened up the dining scene in the West Village, featuring multi-course dessert tastings from **Mauro Pompili** and **Maya Sittisuntorn**. **Jennifer Yang (Yu Garden Dumpling House)** opened two locations of a new casual Chinese concept, **Three Times**, with menus focused on noodles, rice dishes, dumplings, and buns; more locations are planned for Manhattan and beyond. **Bill Yosses** baked up **Palais by Perfect Pie**, an all-day French-American bistro on the Upper East Side. **Merchants Hospitality Group** made it official with its latest concept, **Ivy Lane**, a modern American endeavor cheffed by **Sung Park (Brasserie Seoul)**. **Claudia's** brought Guatemalan cuisine to Williamsburg. **Honeybrains** added a location in the Flatiron District. Greek hit **Kyma** is expanding to Hudson Yards. Flushing is getting an outpost of Beijing-based **Ju Qi**. **K-Food Gallery** is a Korean food hall opening in Midtown next year, with confirmed vendors like **Tiger Sugar**, **Eggdrop**, **BB.Q Chicken**, **Marrizzang**, and **Jongro BBQ**. **Mark Strausman (Fred's at Barneys)** is working on a restaurant of his own, **Mark's Off Madison**, scheduled for a spring debut. Iconic **City Bakery** closed after nearly 30 years in business.
