A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc create a wine that is complex and fruity, spicy and fragrant with notes of tobacco, coffee, leather, and ripe berries.*

## **MEAT MARKET**

*If there were any cardinal rules in our “Meat and Potato” business, the phrase “Steak goes best with Cabernet” would probably be one of them. This may have been true when our founder, Alan Stillman opened Smith & Wollensky back in the 1970’s. However, much has happened in the world of wine since then. So this begs the question: Is this Steak = Cabernet rule still the golden rule? In this section we call the Meat Market, our team has hand-picked a short but diverse list of wines that will work well with any of our cuts of steak.*

### **Rocca di Montegrossi Geremia 2016 Tuscany, IT 150**

*In one of the most fascinating and suitable areas of the Chianti Classico area, near the hamlet of Monti in Chianti. The total extension of the company is equal to 100 hectares, of which 20 are cultivated with vineyards, 20 with olive groves and the rest with woods. The vineyards, all on hilly terrain with gentle slopes, with south and south-east exposure. This wine is made up of 85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon.*

### **Paradigm 2017 Merlot Oakville, Napa 140**

### **Paradigm 2017 Cabernet Franc Oakville, Napa 160**

*Paradigm is made by former Screaming Eagle Winemaker Heidi Peterson-Barrett on a 50 acre parcel of land right next door to the Screaming Eagle estate. For the Paradigm wines, Heidi does everything from grape to bottle by hand in a meticulous fashion. This Cabernet Franc has a plush mouthfeel with flavors of ripe blueberries, black tea, cedar, and peppery spice.*

### **DuMOL ‘Wild Mountainside’ 2018 Syrah Russian River Valley 152**

*Each bottling is built in the vineyard. Soil types, microclimates, plant material, maturity levels, how the vines react to the growing conditions, there are so many detailed variables. The nuance, the depth and complexity of the fruit that results from those variables is the aim to achieve and translate to bottle: purity, vibrancy, freshness, and intensity without heaviness.*

### **Livio Felluga ‘Sossó’ Red Blend 199 2015, Friuli**

*After World War II Livio Felluga was convinced that only high-quality viticulture could breathe new life into the Friulian countryside. With hard work he began to restore old vineyards and plant new ones, introducing innovative ideas and techniques that would help him in the coming years create one of Friuli’s most impressive wineries. This would earn him a universally acknowledged reputation as the man who re-established Friuli’s winemaking heritage.*

### **Duckhorn ‘Three Palms Vineyard’ 2016 Merlot Napa 230**

*Duckhorn is the pioneer winery for producing Merlot in the Napa Valley and have been making Merlot from the legendary Three Palms Vineyard since 1978. Honored as Wine Spectator’s “Wine of the Year,” this wine always receives rave reviews from critics. Rich and concentrated with velvety tannins and complex aromas and flavors of huckleberry, plum, cherry, blueberry, fig, rose, and cocoa.*

Robert Parker says the Colgin IX Estate is “as close to a viticultural nirvana as I’ve ever seen.” Grapes are grown on southeast facing slopes on the estate high atop Pritchard Hill in Napa. This wine is voluptuous and savory with notes of acacia, blackberry, pepper, and coffee.*
