EASTER DINNER AT ANTICA PESA BROOKLYN

Celebrate “Buona Pasqua” with family and friends at Antica Pesa Brooklyn, NYC’s outpost of the iconic Roman restaurant featuring homemade pastas and desserts, the finest Italian imported cheeses and olive oils, and farm-to-table ingredients. A special Easter menu will be available à la carte, or as a four-course feast:
 • Antipasto: Tonno di Conglio (\$18) Slow-cooked rabbit seasoned with lavender and thyme, served with pan brioche and green apple gel
 • Primo: Fettuccine con Ragù di Anatra (\$28) Homemade fettuccine served with slow-cooked duck leg white ragù and topped with candied lime zest and melted cocoa beans
 • Il Secondo: Costolette di Agnello (\$40) Breaded lamb chops fried in clarified butter and served with crispy colorful potato chips and creamy mashed potatoes
 • Il Dolce: Uovo di Pasqua (\$12) Homemade dark chocolate egg filled with mascarpone mousse and topped with warm toffee sauce
 tableside Antica Pesa NY is located at 115 Berry Street, Brooklyn, NY 11249 (between North 7th & 8th Streets in Williamsburg) a short walk from the Bedford Avenue "L" subway stop. The Brooklyn outpost is a sister to the original Antica Pesa in Rome, which dates back to 1922. Both restaurants are owned and operated by the Panella family - Simone Panella oversees the restaurant in Rome while his brother Francesco Panella runs the Brooklyn location.
