### Wine of the Week

Verdicchio is often characterized as 'cheap and cheerful': easy-drinking, bright, citrus-driven wines that don't require much thought or much investment. But a handful of producers, many of whom we're lucky enough to feature on our list - Villa Bucci, Bisci, and of course, San Lorenzo - demonstrate that Verdicchio has the potential to be among the most profound, textural, and expressive wines in Italy. San Lorenzo is a biodynamic estate run by Natalino Crognaletti, who is dedicated to showcasing the finesse and power of Verdicchio, all while emphasizing the integrity of the natural environment; he farms with great care, protects biodiversity within his vineyards, plants crops to improve soil health. (Many of his wines, in fact, are named after the animals with whom he shares his estate.) This Verdicchio, which we are pouring out of magnum, is reminiscent of great Chenin Blanc: enormously textural and aromatically generous, with notes of citrus, stone fruit, chamomile, and herbs, all shot through with blazing acidity that keeps the wines fresh and bright. At Rezdôra, we're committed to showcasing the producers whose work highlights the excellence of Italy's indigenous varietals, challenging the notion that only a handful of so-called 'noble grapes' - think Chardonnay - can produce the great wines of the world. Natalino's Verdicchios are another entry into this canon: it's impossible to deny that Italy offers some of the finest white wines around once you've tasted them.

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## Featured Wines: Italy's Iconic Producers

There is reasonable argument to be made that Italy is the most exciting winemaking country in the world today. From the stalwart regions of Piemonte and Toscana to the lesser-known areas brimming with creativity and ingenuity, Italy offers something for drinkers of all stripes across the ranges of style and price. And this is to say nothing of Italy's unique tradition of maintaining and celebrating its indigenous varietals, of which hundreds are recognized and likely over a thousand exist. But for this holiday season, we wanted to pay homage to a few of Italy's most legendary, celebrated producers, whose influence is felt throughout the peninsula and beyond. While many of these wines are a significant investment, consider them akin to a plane ticket to Rome: unique opportunities to taste living art from some of Italy's finest artisans.

### *Bartolo Mascarello, Barolo, Piemonte*

Ask any sommelier, collector, or even winemaker who is the most essential producer of Barolo, and most, if not all, will point to Bartolo Mascarello. A staunch traditionalist, Mascarello makes but one Barolo a year, blending from four crus - three in the village of Barolo, and one in La Morra. These wines undergo long, continuous fermentations, are aged exclusively in large oak grandi botti, which impart no wood flavors to the wine, and are remarkably ageworthy, evolving for half a century - if not longer. Bartolo was also notoriously opinionated and political; each year, he releases an 'Artists Label' bottling, and the most famous of these was stamped 'No Barrique, No Berlusconi' - a protest against both a political regime, and the Modernist trend of using small French barriques in Barolo. But his most unwavering commitment was to producing beautiful wine. Now helmed by Bartolo's daughter, Maria Teresa, many argue that the wines have only gotten better. Barolo lovers, take heed: this is as good as it gets.

### *Gaja, Piemonte*

In many ways, Gaja lies at the opposite end of the philosophical spectrum from Bartolo Mascarello. They introduced the first single-vineyard wines in Piemonte, while Mascarello continues to this day to produce only one Barolo, a blend of crus; they introduced Bordeaux varietals and the use of French barriques, while Mascarello vehemently opposes using anything other than traditional large botti. But their influence is unmistakable, helping to elevate Piemontese wine to the global heights it has reached today. Their approach produces wines of tremendous elegance and structure; one sip, and you'll see why the name Gaja has become synonymous with luxury and excellence.

## Featured Wines: Italy's Iconic Producers

### *Paolo Bea, Umbria*

Natural wine is having its moment. In New York City, you can barely sneeze without being in range of a wine bar or restaurant that professes that its list is predominantly or entirely 'natural' (Nota bene: there's little agreement as to what this term means; for some, it's about the integrity of the farming and winemaking, while for others, it's about the funk factor. For those interested, the vast majority of wines on our list are organically farmed, fermented with indigenous yeast, and bottled with minimal sulfur.) But before natural wine was cool, Paolo Bea was making some of the most soulful, expressive, quintessential natural wines in Umbria. He works with a handful of grapes, most notably Trebbiano Spoletino, Sangiovese, and Umbria's noble red grape, Sagrantino. From the black tea inflected, notably tannic 'Arboreus' to the balsamic, unctuous 'Pagliaro,' these wines are the Great Books of the natural wine canon. If you don't fear a touch of funk, these will knock your socks off.

### *Emidio Pepe, Abruzzo*

Emidio Pepe's wines are an emotional experience. Considered one of the two giants of Abruzzese wine, alongside Eduardo Valentini, Pepe's wines have become increasingly rare - we were only able to get two bottles of each vintage. Farmed organically, hand-harvested and destemmed, fermented in glass-lined tanks, bottled without sulfur, and often aged at the estate for as long as ten years before release, these wines are a paragon of craftsmanship and expressiveness. They may be some of the most soulful, evocative, complex wines in the world today.

### *Valdicava, Toscana*

Nothing tricky here - just brilliant, inspired winemaking. Farming in the Montosoli Valley in Montalcino, Valdicava has been producing, year after year, some of the most balanced, age-worthy, elegant, complex Brunelli on the market. The wines have developed something of a cult following, with rarity and price to match, but they remain among the most reliable, pure expressions of Tuscan Sangiovese around. Now helmed by PierFilippo Abbruzzese, Valdicava is undertaking experiments to determine how best to continue producing top-tier Brunello in the face of climate change. If you're a fan of Brunello, these wines are quickly becoming archetypes in the region and beyond.

## Grappa e Distillati

### Distillati di Capovilla, Veneto

Vittorio Gianni Capovilla was an unlikely candidate to ascend to the mantle of the greatest distiller in Italy - and, arguably, the world. He spent the majority of his career as a Formula 3 racecar mechanic in Switzerland, but his travel throughout Austria and Germany left him fascinated with the small home distilleries he found on the properties of nearly every farmer and winemaker. Italy is not well-known for distillation because of the stringent regulations surrounding them; while Austria houses over 90,000 distilleries, in Italy there are only about 120. Willing to take on the challenge, he commissioned an Austrian artisan to build him a double bain-marie alembic still, which requires a time-consuming and painstaking distillation process, in 1986, and began producing both grappa and fruit distillates, sourcing the base fruit from his own farm, along with other organic farms in the region, and some of Italy's top winemakers - Gravner, Dal Forno, and Soldera among them. While Italian regulations allow the use of up to 20% added sugar and 3% aromatic enhancements, Vittorio chooses to forgo both, producing a spirit that is the purest expression of the fruit used as its base. These distillates are produced in achingly small quantities - sometimes fewer than 275 bottles, each only 375mL - and are simply profound expressions of Italian terroir. These soulful pours are unparalleled, and the painstaking process involved in sourcing and distilling the fruit makes these artful libations more than worth the price. ### Grappa di Nonino, Friuli

In many ways, Nonino's story is a study in contrasts with that of Capovilla: they have been making Grappa since 1897, and now operate five separate distilleries, each with 12 steam copper stills. But their size and success correlate to their essential role in the modernization of grappa. Previously considered a peasant's beverage, distilled from the leftover grape pomace (seeds, skins, and a bit of liquid) after the winemaking process, Grappa rose to prominence when Nonino felt it was necessary to produce it as a premium, artisanal after-dinner beverage. They bottled the first single-varietal grappa in 1973 using the Picolit grape, and are now well-known for their single-varietal grappa distillates. (Fun fact: the Nonino family also funds an annual literary award called the International Nonino Prize; previously intended to reward those who helped preserve Friulian traditions, it is now a prestigious award for writers all around the globe.) These grappa are pure distillates of varietals that are important to the Friulian and international wine heritage, and are widely considered among the most quintessential grappa on the market today.
