Falcon Lakes Golf Club Staying Open

During this stressful time, we believe that a golf course, our course spread out over 176 acres, can provide a safe place for you to enjoy fresh air, the beauty of spring unfolding, a little exercise, and some fellowship-while maintaining social distancing and safe practices.

The Professional Golfers' Association (PGA), Golf Club Managers' Association (GCMA) and British and International Golf Greenkeepers Association (BIGGA) have issued new guidance on what to do when playing and how to do it safely during the coronavirus pandemic. We will implement these guidelines as well as those from the CDC and other health agencies.

Here are the procedures we are taking to ensure a safe experience at Falcon Lakes Golf Club.

- Tee times will be spread out to enhance social distancing.
- Individual carts will be provided.
- Payment for each tee time is to be done online, via our website or through the GolfNow app
- Access to the pro shop will be restricted to provide safe distancing between employees and customers. Purchase of range balls, merchandise, etc. will be done just outside the golf shop.
- Access to the restrooms will be through the bar & grille with limit of two customers at one time.
- All food and beverage will be "Carryout" only, with no dine in. A wonderful menu has been developed for this purpose with quality fresh made items.
- Rakes, ball washers, water coolers and other items have been removed.
- Golf carts, rest rooms, doors, handles, etc. will be sanitized frequently each day.

We're going to do everything reasonably possible to provide you a safe, enjoyable recreational experience to aid all of us in getting through this unprecedented situation. We will get through this, hopefully within six weeks, and be able to resume our normal operations. The golf course will be maintained to the same excellent level it has been, with continued improvements.

We applaud the spirit of extremely dedicated employees and are very grateful for all of you, our very valued customers. Your patience is requested during this time of many changes, which will continue to occur as we adjust daily to health guidelines for our employees and you.
