*Cuvee Niña*

Champagne, France NV - Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier

Made by a small, family-run grower who farms their own vineyards and favors minimal intervention, this Champagne is all about purity, place, and finesse over flash. Bright, elegant, and quietly expressive, with crisp orchard fruit, subtle citrus, and a fine, persistent mousse. A clean mineral backbone keeps it fresh and balanced—perfect as a first glass or an easygoing sip.

*1er Cru Brut Extra Blanc de Blanc*

Champagne, France NV - Chardonnay

Softly marshmallowy, airy, and cloud-like on the palate — all whipped texture and luminous lift, never heavy, never sharp. Lemon cream, chalk dust, and a gentle sweetness that feels more nostalgic than sugary. Elegant, weightless, and quietly emotional. This Champagne doesn't shout — it hovers.

*1er Cru Brut Blanc de Noir*

Champagne, France NV - Pinot Noir

This is Pinot Noir in a tailored tuxedo. A grower Champagne with a distinctly Burgundian sensibility — structured, grounded, and quietly luxurious without tipping into excess. Toasted brioche, ripe orchard fruit, and a hint of spice glide beneath the bubbles, offering richness without weight. It suggests decadence without ever going over the edge — the way great Burgundy does: more about texture, balance, and restraint than flash.

Champagne, France NV - Pinot Meunier

This Champagne calls to mind winter in the countryside. Bare trees, cold air, and the quiet stillness that comes once everything has been stripped back. Pinot Meunier leads with texture and presence, offering something grounding rather than glossy. There's a savory, earthy undercurrent and a soft, rounded feel that makes it comforting without being heavy. It's introspective and unshowy, like walking through a vineyard after harvest, dusted with frost and perfectly silent. Calm, thoughtful, and understated.

*Les Riceys Brut Nature Rosé*

Champagne, France NV - Pinot Noir

Exclusive to Bocage

Crafted by Drappier, an eighth-generation grower-producer in the Aube, this wine reflects centuries of Pinot Noir expertise. Dark, intense, and unapologetically serious, this Brut Nature rosé is made using the saignée method—whole-cluster Pinot Noir macerated to extract deep color, structure, and aromatics before pressing. With zero dosage, nothing masks the wine's raw precision, allowing the Aube's south-facing Kimmeridgian limestone to speak clearly and without compromise. And here's the part we're most proud of: Les Riceys Rosé is exported directly from Drappier to Bocage Champagne Bar. You won't find it anywhere else. Golden, rare, and one-of-a-kind — much like Bocage itself.
