Trop m’en Faut!

Champagne, France NV - Fromentau

A true rarity in Champagne: this cuvée is crafted entirely from Fromenteau (better known as Pinot Gris), one of the seven historic “heritage” grapes of the region that only a handful of producers still champion. The Drappier family, guardians of tradition since 1808, vinifies this grape into a sparkling wine that is both surprising and deeply expressive. Expect ripe orchard fruit, peach skin, and gentle florals on the nose, carried by a supple mousse and a palate that’s equal parts textured and refreshing.

A Champagne first! Drappier Éclose 2012 is an extraordinary cuvée with notes of white peach, wild berries, vanilla, and licorice, all carried by a fine, mineral-driven mousse. Éclose means “hatched”—a nod to Ovum, Drappier’s pioneering egg-shaped oak cask, where the wine matured for three years as its curved form encouraged a natural, continuous circulation. Made from 60% Pinot Noir and 40% Chardonnay from the Grande Sendrée vineyards, it then spent ten years aging on the lees in bottle. Only around 3,000 bottles were produced, making this an exceptionally rare taste of Champagne history in the making.

The crème de la crème! Salon Le Mesnil is a rare and exquisite experience with notes of citrus, white flowers, and a chalky minerality that’s simply divine. Made exclusively from Chardonnay grapes from a single Grand Cru vineyard in Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, this Blanc de Blancs is only produced in exceptional vintages. Salon, founded in the early 20th century, is synonymous with luxury and exclusivity, producing just a few thousand bottles each year.
