Peter Lauer, Réserve Sekt 150.
Riesling | Ayl Germany '88

"Méthode Champenois" style of Riesling from one of Germany's greatest producers. Hand-riddled and cellared for over a quarter century, it was finally disgorged this year and is 31 years young! Simply put, the wine is pure lightning, with a striking citrus and green apple core. Even after three decades this wine is unbelievably sharp. A stunning alternative for anyone who likes to drink brut style Champagne.

Cara Sur 50.
Moscatel Blanco | Barreal, Valle de Calingasta, Argentina '18

This wine shows what Moscatel can be as a dry wine. It's unfiltered, unfiltered, and is one of the most interesting whites coming out of Argentina. Extended skin contact in concrete yields wafts of ripe green apples and thyme on the nose. Continuing on the palate with a properly dry, almost tannic white wine, with high acidity, richly textured mid palate and masses of eye-watering orchard fruit.

SOMM PICKS

Txakolina, Ameztoi Rosé 40.
Hondarrabi Zuri/Hondarrabi Beltza | Getariako, Spain '17

Perhaps some of the most locally sought after rosé. Every spring New Orleans wondrously gets a small allotted amount of this Basque Country rosé. Grown close to thee Bay of Biscay and bottled with residual carbonic acid, giving the wine its iconic "spritzy" and saline minerality. If not already, this can easily become anyone's favorite rosé.

Dominio di Bagnoli, Friularo di Bagnoli Classico 45.
Friularo | Tuscany, Italy '15

A wine steeped in history, Dominio di Bagnoli started in 954 with the construction of a Benedictine monastery. In the 15th century it was converted to a fattoria equipped with a theatre, cellars, granary, and magnificent gardens. It's wine and scenery attracted bohemians of the time, held splendid feasts and inspired many poems. The Borletti family now organically takes care of these rare vineyards and ancient cellars. Here with the help of old oak barriques, they sculpt velvety, almost stewed cherry-like reds with spicy structure.
