***Alemtary Mr. Stevens Nitro** (Hackensack, NJ) \$6
3.8% English mild ale that's not too heavy

***Allagash White** (Portland, ME) \$6
5% Traditional Belgian wheat beer that balances full flavor with a crisp, refreshing taste and subtle hints of spice

***Bell's Porter** (Comstock, MI) \$7
5.6% Notes of chocolate, coffee and roasted barley are offset with just a slight hop bitterness

***Bolero Snort Boysenberry Moosaic**(Ridgefield Park,NJ) \$7
6% 100% Mosaic IPA with Milk Sugar + Boysenberry

***Brix City Just Another Dbl IPA**(Little Ferry, NJ) \$8
9% Double IPA double dry hopped with all amarillo hops

***Brooklyn Bel-Air Sour** (Brooklyn, NY) \$7
5.8% Bright notes of tropical fruit with crisp and gently tartness

Budweiser Copper Lager (St. Louis, MI) \$5
6.2% Aged on real Jim Beam Bourbon barrel staves for a toasted Oak aroma, a deliciously nutty taste with Caramel Rye and Vanilla notes

Champlain Mac & Maple (Shoreham, VT) \$6
6% McIntosh apple cider with just the right amount of Vermont Maple Syrup

Chimay Grand Reserve (Blue)(Baileux, Belgium) \$9
9% Belgian strong ale whose fragrance of fresh yeast with a light, flowery rosy touch is especially pleasant

Delirium Tremens (Melle, Belgium) \$9
8.5% Nominated as one of the "best beers in the world"

***Departed Soles Trust Fun Baby** (Jersey City, NJ) \$7
6.1%A more traditional saison, brewed with sorachi ace and lemon drop hops.

***Dogfish Head American Beauty** (Milton, DE) \$8
6.5% American strong ale brewed with all-American malts and hops, granola and little bit of soul

***Ellicotville Choc. Cherry Bomb**(Ellicotville, NY) \$8
8.2% Heavy notes of chocolate, tart cherries, and coffee roast

***Foolproof Vanilla Espresso Raincloud** (Pawtucket, RI) \$7
6% Rich, malty porter and blended in whole vanilla beans and espresso-ground coffee

***Fort Nonsense Benedict Amber** (Denville, NJ) \$6
5.4% Malt-forward amber ale with a medium hop profile

***Hoboken No Sleep Till Boken** (Hoboken, NJ) \$7
7.8% A hop bomb that finishes with a little malty sweetness and fruitiness

***Interboro Real Love IPA** (Brooklyn, NY) \$8
9% Double IPA with dank apricot aroma, with apricot nectar flavor and citrus bite

***Jughandle Crimes of Passion IPA** (Tinton Falls, NJ) \$7
6.5% Waves of delightfully pleasant citrus and fruit juice from the additions of Citra, Southern Passion, and Styrian Dragon hops

***Kane Head High** (Ocean, NJ) \$7
6.5% This beer is all about the hops

***Lagunitas IPA** (Petaluma, CA) \$7
6.2% Malt and hops working together to balance out this IPA

***Magnify Mind Over Matter** (Fairfield, NJ) \$7
8% Brewed with lactose for a bigger mouthfeel, body and sweetness, and conditioned on cocoa nibs and vanilla

***Maine Lunch** (Freeport, ME) \$7
7% Intense hop flavors and aromas of tropical and citrus fruits and pine dominate

***New Belgium Fat Tire** (Fort Collins, CO) \$6
5.2% Balance of toasty, biscuit-like malt flavors coasting in equilibrium with hoppy freshness

***Peak Organic Happy Hour** (Portland, ME) \$6
4.6% Crisp, light lager brewed for maximum crushability

***Sam Adams Boston Lager** (Boston, MA) \$6
5% Full, rich flavor that is both balanced and complex

***Terrapin Hopsecutioner** (Athens, GA) \$6
7.3% You may lose your hophead over this one!

***Troegs Nugget Nectar** (Hershey, PA) \$10
7.5% Squeeze those hops for all they're worth and prepare to pucker up!

***Victory Winter Cheers** (Downingtown,PA) \$3
6.7% Delivers a refreshing finish, with spicy hints of banana, clove and citrus
