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- **Biodynamic** ~ Biodynamic wines are Demeter certified or following the principles of Biodynamic farming. Essentially, this particular way of farming is an organic and holistic approach to understanding the vine from soil health to preserving the land for future generations.

- ▲ **Organic** ~ Made with organically grown fruit. Grape Growers are organic farming certified or practicing the principles of organic farming.

- **Natural** ~ The natural wine we choose for our wine list follows four essential rules: made with organic grapes; minimal intervention from the winemaker; indigenous yeast fermentations; minimal SO₂ treatments.

- ★ **Orange** ~ White wines that have extended skin contact. This imbues the wine with texture and color which is derived from the skins of the grapes. Depending on the length of time that wines are left on the skins the resulting color and texture will vary in intensity.

Mary's Sommelier Selections

It is impossible to talk about Hirsch Vineyards and not mention its geographic location. Situated at the extreme edge of the Sonoma Coast within the AVA (American Viticultural Area) of Fort Ross Seaview.

Hirsch Vineyards sits high on a coastal ridge where there is no protection from the elements. The San Andreas Faultline was a pivotal part of how this landscape formed.

Perched overlooking the Pacific Ocean there is no protection from the elements. Formerly this land was a wild sheep ranch. David Hirsch, a Beatnik and a Buddhist, discovered this property in the late 70's. Immediately entranced it called to him with promises of a life that was more grounded to the land and ruled by the elements.

Hirsch Vineyards calls Martinelli, Marcassin, Flowers and other highly lauded wineries its neighbors. Family owned and operated with 2nd Generation Jasmine Hirsch at the helm. Jasmine Hirsch is also the winemaker evoking pure chiseled expression of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. The wines showcase the elements of which they are born.

 ~ There is a quiet revolution in Champagne happening when it comes to how the vineyards are farmed. Incrementally, growers and wine makers (sometimes one and the same) are leaving behind conventional farming practices and looking towards sustainability.
 ~ Benoît Marguet is one of approximately 150 growers and producers who have adopted biodynamic farming methods. Champagne houses such as Champagne Fleury, Champagne Leclerc Brian, Champagne Larmandier-Bernier and Louis Roederer (over half their estate is farmed biodynamically) are all champions of biodynamic farming.
 ~ This fantastic Champagne has a core of baked apples and tart citrus. As it opens up expect notes of Marzipan and toasted almond. The finish is long and savory with a touch of saline. A blend of 84% Pinot Noir and 16% Chardonnay sourced from elite Grand Cru parcels in Ambonnay and Bouzy. No added dosage and virtually no added sulfur.

 ~ All vineyards are 100% biodynamically farmed. This requires a serious commitment to traditional agricultural practices and a deep understanding of the local flora and fauna. Minimal intervention in the wine making process allows the terroir to truly express itself.
 ~ This delightful sparkling wine made in the traditional Champagne Method shows a beautiful frothy mousse and notes of slivered almonds along with brioche, shimmering citrus and a lively mouth watering finish.

 ~ Established in 1971 by Josh Jensen, Calera, is inspired by Josh Jensen’s mentors in Burgundy who were very passionate about chardonnay being grown in limestone. Josh Jensen was determined to find a vineyard location in California with limestone soils and Calera was born.
 ~Winemaker Notes: Grown high on the limestone-rich soils of Mt. Harlan, this wine is an aromatic beauty, revealing layers of white peach, fresh-cut grass, lavender and lemon verbena. Though rich and round on the palate, its cool-climate origins ensure a lively underlying acidity that provides focus and finesse to tropical flavors of guava, pineapple and vanilla bean.

Chardonnay - Chablis

61.0620 **Domaine Laroche, Chablis Grand Cru Les Clos, FR 2022.....\$360**

~ Chablis is the northernmost region of the esteemed and world renowned region of Burgundy. The vineyards are planted on Kimmeridgian soils, an ancient bed of fossilized oyster shells, which are said to imbue these wines with their crushed oyster shell minerality and ocean breeze finish.

~ Domaine Laroche was established in 1850. They cellar and age their wine in the L'Obédiencerie, a former monastery in the village of Chablis.

~ Occasionally we come across a wine that is undeniable, this is one of them. Lime blossom and citrus fruits envelope the senses. Aromas of flint, linden flowers and tart pomme fruits round out the dry mineral driven finish.

Located high atop the Mayacamas Mountains at an elevation of 2,000 feet in the Mount Veeder AVA, Mayacamas was founded by John Henry Fisher, a German immigrant who saw the potential of the rugged mountain terrain for growing exceptional grapes. During Prohibition, Mayacamas managed to survive by selling grapes to home winemakers and producing sacramental wine.

~ Some of the most dynamic and powerful wines come from the Mountain AVAs (American Viticultural Area) of Napa Valley. Mayacamas is unique in that the compressed volcanic ash, fractured volcanic cobbles, gravelly loam, and cobbled clay soils that the Cabernet Sauvignon grapes are grown in on Mount Veeder are allowed to shine through. Aging and fermentation vessels are a mixture of concrete tanks, stainless steel tanks and oak cooperage typically only about 10% new oak. If you are craving an opulent style of Cabernet this is not the wine for you.

~ The 2019 Ornellaia has a significant portion of the blend dedicated to Cabernet Sauvignon. The Cabernet Sauvignon shines through with exceptional concentration, power and finesse. Loads of dark stone and brambly fruits entice the senses. Complex and seductive the wine reveals notes of leather and spice as it opens. The finish is lengthy and complex with a well balanced dry but velvety finish.
