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- Biodynamic ~ Biodynamic wines are Demeter certified or following the principles of Biodynamic farming. Essentially, this particular way of farming is an organic and holistic approach to understanding the vine from soil health to preserving the land for future generations.
- ▲ Organic ~ Made with organically grown fruit. Grape Growers are organic farming certified or practicing the principles of organic farming.
- Natural ~ The natural wine we choose for our wine list follows four essential rules: made with organic grapes; minimal intervention from the winemaker; indigenous yeast fermentations; minimal SO₂ treatments.
- ★ Orange ~ White wines that have extended skin contact. This imbues the wine with texture and color which is derived from the skins of the grapes. Depending on the length of time that wines are left on the skins the resulting color and texture will vary in intensity.

Mary's Sommelier Selections

It is impossible to talk about Hirsch Vineyards and not mention its geographic location. Situated at the extreme edge of the Sonoma Coast within the AVA (American Viticultural Area) of Fort Ross Seaview.

Hirsch Vineyards sits high on a coastal ridge where there is no protection from the elements. The San Andreas Faultline was a pivotal part of how this landscape formed.

Perched overlooking the Pacific Ocean there is no protection from the elements. Formerly this land was a wild sheep ranch. David Hirsch, a Beatnik and a Buddhist, discovered this property in the late 70's. Immediately entranced it called to him with promises of a life that was more grounded to the land and ruled by the elements.

Hirsch Vineyards calls Martinelli, Marcassin, Flowers and other highly lauded wineries its neighbors. Family owned and operated with 2nd Generation Jasmine Hirsch at the helm. Jasmine Hirsch is also the winemaker evoking pure chiseled expression of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. The wines showcase the elements of which they are born.

 ~ There is a quiet revolution in Champagne happening when it comes to how the vineyards are farmed. Incrementally, growers and wine makers (sometimes one and the same) are leaving behind conventional farming practices and looking towards sustainability.
 ~ Benoît Marguet is one of approximately 150 growers and producers who have adopted biodynamic farming methods. Champagne houses such as Champagne Fleury, Champagne Leclerc Brian, Champagne Larmandier-Bernier and Louis Roederer (over half their estate is farmed biodynamically) are all champions of biodynamic farming.
 ~ This fantastic Champagne has a core of baked apples and tart citrus. As it opens up expect notes of Marzipan and toasted almond. The finish is long and savory with a touch of saline. A blend of 84% Pinot Noir and 16% Chardonnay sourced from elite Grand Cru parcels in Ambonnay and Bouzy. No added dosage and virtually no added sulfur.

Sparkling Sommelier Highlight

 ~ Benanti is a pioneering estate founded in 1988 on Mount Etna, Sicily, by Dr. Giuseppe Benanti, who revived the region's viticulture by championing native grapes. Today, his sons Antonio and Salvino run the family business, which is globally renowned for crafting precise, volcanic-terroir-driven wines.
 ~ Introduced as a groundbreaking experiment in 2002, the "Noblesse" Metodo Classico is made from 100% indigenous Carricante grapes. The 2022 vintage is sourced from 20- to 60-year-old vines grown at high altitudes of 700 to 850 meters in mineral-rich, volcanic soils, before undergoing secondary bottle fermentation.
 ~ This pale straw-yellow sparkling wine offers delicate aromas of orange blossom and yellow apple. On the palate, it is dry, elegant, and medium-bodied, featuring a fine mousse, crisp acidity, and a signature stony, mineral-driven finish.

Oregon - Sparkling Rosé - Pinot Noir

 ~ Soter Vineyards is a 250-acre Biodynamic farm and vineyard located in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA of Oregon's Willamette Valley. The estate focuses on respectful farming, ancient marine soils, and cool-climate grape growing. They specialize in nuanced Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and traditional-method sparkling wines.
 ~ Tony Soter founded the winery in 1997 after a famous career making wine in Napa Valley. He and his late wife, Michelle, moved to Oregon full-time in 2006 to build Mineral Springs Ranch. Interestingly, their very first bottling in 1997 was a Brut Rosé, establishing a deep house tradition for sparkling wine that continues today.
 ~ The 2019 Mineral Springs Brut Rosé is a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay aged for three and a half years on the lees. It displays a gentle salmon color with lively, persistent bubbles. The wine offers bright flavors of blood orange, red cherry, and raspberry sorbet, mixed with soft notes of rose petal and subtle minerality on a crisp finish.

California - Chardonnay

- 50.0400 ▲ **Calera, Mt Harlan, San Benito County, CA 2018**.....\$118
 ~ Calera Wine Company is an acclaimed estate in San Benito County, California, operating as the sole winery within the rugged Mt. Harlan AVA. Perched at 2,200 feet, its gravity-flow facility is named after a historic on-site limestone kiln. This extreme, high-altitude setting exposes organic vineyards to cool maritime winds and rare limestone soils, producing low-yielding, intensely concentrated fruit.
 ~ Founder Josh Jensen established the estate in 1975 to recreate Burgundy-style wines in California's rare limestone soils. After training at legendary French estates like Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, Jensen purchased the remote quarry and planted Chardonnay in 1984. His pioneering vision made Calera a benchmark for New World varietals.
 ~ The 2018 Calera Mt. Harlan Chardonnay offers a vibrant, crisp expression of this mountain terroir. The nose features white peach, honeysuckle, and sea salt. The palate balances a rich texture of guava and poached pear with a sharp streak of limestone minerality and bright acidity, finishing with elegant notes of toasted brioche.

Chardonnay - Côte-de-Beaune - Meursault

- 61.0684 ● **Domaine Roulot, 1er Cru Clos de Bouchères, Meursault, FR 2023**.....\$1,027
 ~ Domaine Roulot is a legendary Burgundy estate in Meursault specializing in world-class, mineral-driven Chardonnays. Winemaker Jean-Marc Roulot uses minimal new oak to prioritize purity, precision, and terroir expression. His unmatched ability to capture the unique identity of individual parcels has earned him a reputation as the definitive master of Meursault.
 ~ The estate dates to the 1930s, gaining fame under Guy Roulot before his son Jean-Marc took over in 1989. In 2011, the family acquired the iconic 1.38-hectare monopoly site, Clos des Bouchères, known for its shallow, stony limestone soils.
 ~ The 2023 vintage offers vibrant aromas of white flowers, orange zest, and nutmeg. The palate is sleek and precise with electric acidity, finishing with a long, chalky, and intensely saline edge. This combination of structural tension and concentrated fruit ensures the wine will evolve beautifully in the cellar for decades.

Aromas of fresh red cherry, hibiscus tea, and cinnamon bark rise from the glass, complemented by subtle earthy undertones of wet stone. The palate is smooth and supple, featuring medium body, vibrant acidity, and finessed tannins that carry through a fresh finish.

Granja Nuestra Señora de Remelluri is a pioneering single-estate winery in Rioja Alavesa, Spain. Led by Telmo Rodríguez, the organic estate sits high in the Sierra de Toloño mountains. It is celebrated for its low-intervention "mountain Rioja" style, prioritizing terroir over industrial blending.

The property dates to the 10th century and was later a monastic farm producing wine by 1596. Purchased by Jaime Rodríguez Salís in 1967, the estate released its inaugural 1971 vintage. This marked the very first modern Rioja wine bottled exclusively from a single, château-style estate.

The Remelluri Reserva 2008—a blend of Tempranillo, Garnacha, and Graciano—presents a mature ruby color with complex aromas of dark cherry, tobacco, leather, and balsamic herbs. The palate is medium-bodied and savory, driven by vibrant acidity and fine, well-integrated tannins. Aged in oak barrels and heavily cellared, it finishes long and balanced with lingering notes of licorice and subtle spice.
